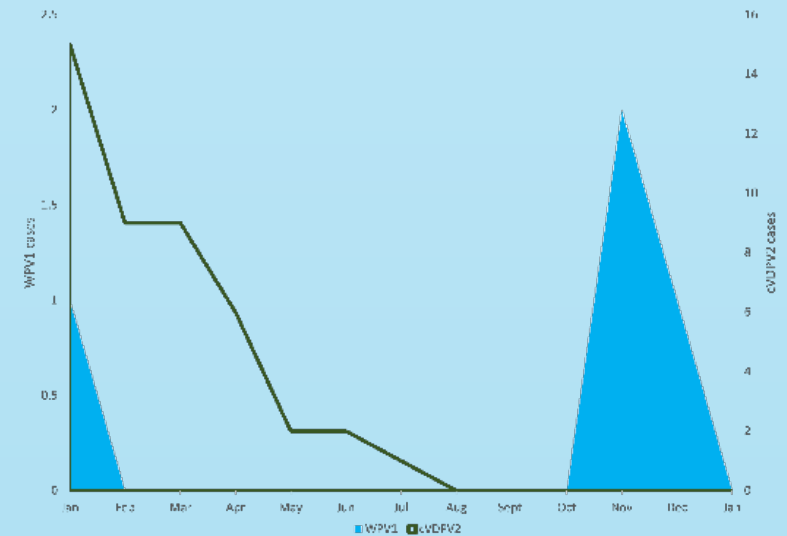


WPV1 and cVDPV2 cases in January 2022

POLIO TRANSMISSION

- No new Wild Poliovirus (WPV1) cases and no new cVDPV2 cases confirmed in January 2022



AFP / ENVIRONMENTAL SURVEILLANCE

- 227 children with Acute Flaccid Paralysis (AFP) - 102 females and 125 males - were reported in January 2022. A total of 227 AFP cases have been reported since the beginning of 2022. Of these, 60 cases have been discarded as non-polio. About 167 cases are pending final classification
- The non-polio AFP rate remained above 10, stool adequacy stood above 89%, and non-polio enterovirus rate was 16-22% in all regions
- No new WPV1 and no new cVDPV2 positive environmental samples were confirmed in January 2022



SUPPLEMENTARY VACCINATION ACTIVITIES

- 8,561,214 children were vaccinated against polio during the January NIDs



COMPLEMENTARY VACCINATION ACTIVITIES

- 12 cross-border vaccination points, 45 cross-border teams and 638 permanent transit teams (PTTs) were operational in January 2022
- Permanent transit teams vaccinated 831,865 children, and cross-border teams vaccinated 96,945 children against polio in January 2022
- 196 children under 10 were given OPV in UNHCR repatriation centre and IOM sites receiving returnees and refugees from Pakistan and Iran in January 2022
- By the end of January 2022, 196 returnee children were vaccinated with OPV
- 377 international travelers were vaccinated in January 2022 in compliance with IHR



Key communication activities

- 173,677 caregivers were engaged on issues related to polio, routine immunization, maternal and child health promotion, and COVID-19 preventative measures across south, southeast, west, and northeast regions
- 344,498 children under five were given polio vaccine drops, 27,822 children under two were vaccinated for routine immunization and 16,919 women and girls received tetanus vaccine across the target health facilities
- 652,985 females were reached with polio and mother and child health awareness messages by the female mobilizers/vaccinators (FMVs) through 57,956 face-to-face sessions in the south, southeast, west, and east regions
- 4,408 individuals, including religious influencers, local authorities and community influencers were reached with awareness in the south, southeast, west, and northeast regions
- 128,820 soap bars and 28,221 baby blankets were distributed to 138 health centres in the south and west regions
- 235 children and adults received referrals by ICN (145 specifically made for routine immunization) in the northeast region. All the referrals have been utilized
- 2,287 elderly women from across the south region were engaged in multiple meetings to promote women's role in polio eradication efforts
