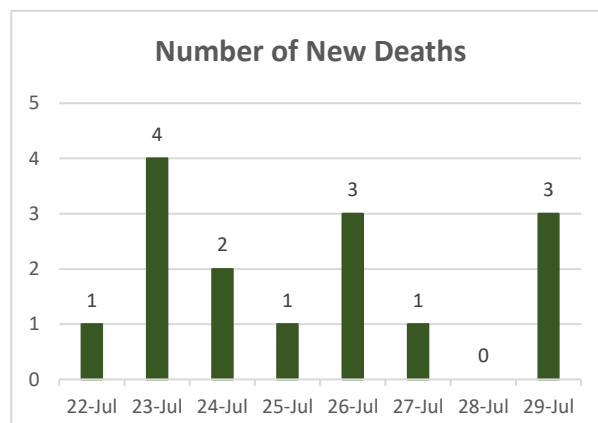
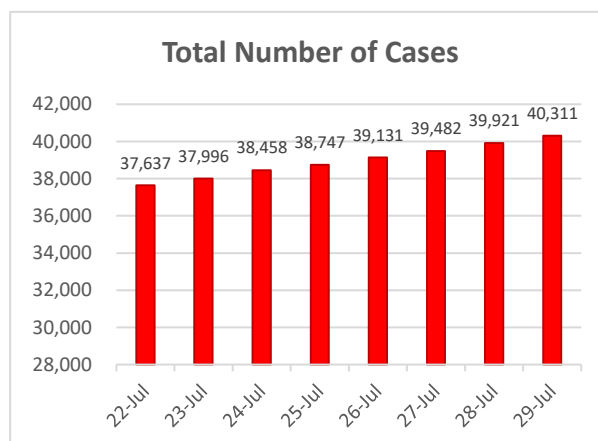
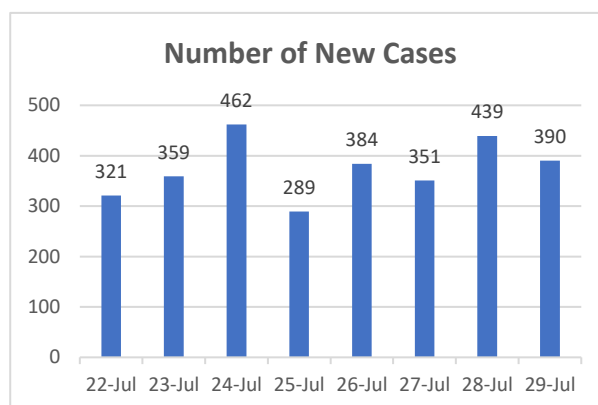

HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortalities were: a 64 years old male Bahraini citizen and 2 male expatriates (54 and 64 years old).
- MoH published health measures to be observed by restaurants and coffee shops to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.
- A remote conference focusing on genetic studies related to COVID-19 was held yesterday under the patronage of Health Minister.
- An infected person was sentenced to 3 years in jail for deliberately transmitting the virus to doctors working at the screening centre.
- Health Minister inspects the quarantine centre in Hidd as an appreciation of the tremendous efforts of the health sector workers.
- 30 volunteers work with the Information and E-Government team in support of the national efforts to combat Coronavirus.
- Mass gatherings during Eid al-Adha holiday have been banned to avoid a surge in coronavirus cases.
