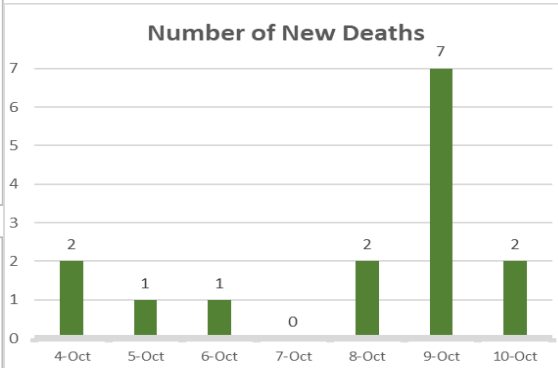
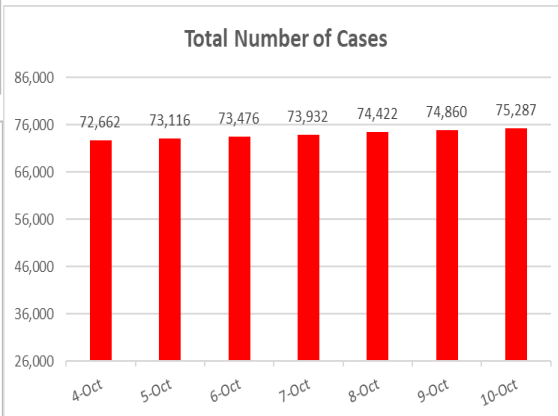
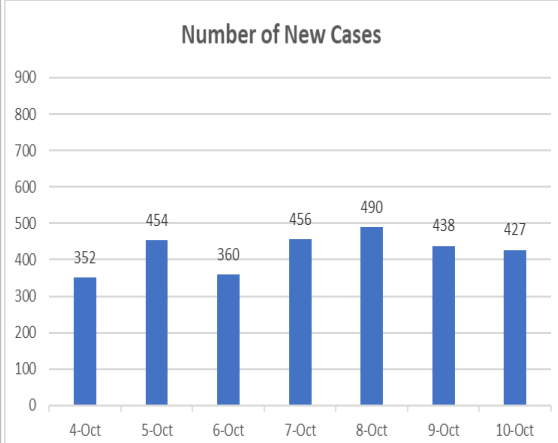

HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortality were: 8 Bahraini Citizens [5 female (56, 77, 79, 80 and 82 years old) and 3 male (62,67 and 70 years old)] and 3 male expatriate (38, 43 and 70 years old).
- H.E. the Minister of Health met with the President of the Good Word Society and received Isa bin Ali Al Khalifa Award for Voluntary Work
- National Taskforce for Combating the Coronavirus highlighted that Bahrain has displayed extraordinary resilience in fighting Covid-19 pandemic, setting an exemplary model for the world in patient safety and infection control.
- A webinar focusing on patient safety was opened on Thursday with sessions on the evolution, diagnosis, treatment and prevention of the coronavirus.
- Three days ahead of the National Assembly Third Term, all MPs and Parliament employees have undergone Covid-19 testing.
- Board of Trustees of Governmental Hospitals held a Coordination Meeting with the employees of Salmaniya Medical Complex in the presence of the Chairman and members of the Board of Trustees of Governmental Hospitals.
- Ministry of Education completed preparations for the commencement of online learning during the first two weeks of the new academic year, starting from Sunday, 11 October 2020.
- Parents have been urged to stay connected with their children and closely observe changes in their behaviour concerning a rise in anxiety among students during the Covid-19 pandemic.
