HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortality were: a 63 years old female Bahraini Citizens and a 48 years old male expatriate.
- His Majesty the King opened the third session of the fifth legislative term for the National Assembly remotely, announcing plans for a new specialist hospital and medical centre on infectious diseases.
- Minister of Health praised the speech of His Majesty the King, affirming that the royal directive for infectious diseases hospital reflects his deep care on health for all.

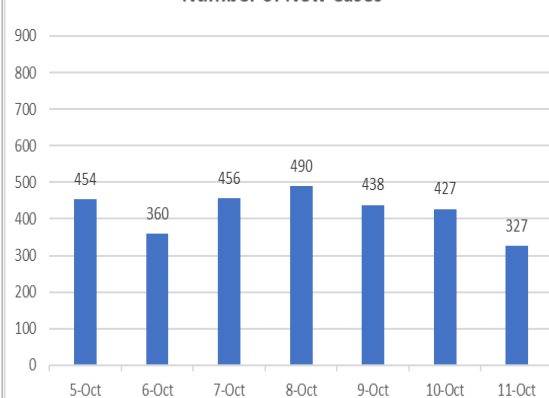

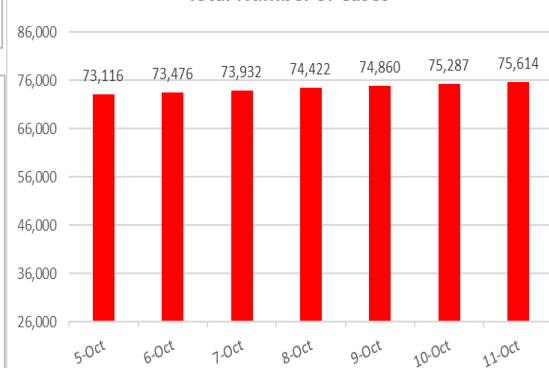
