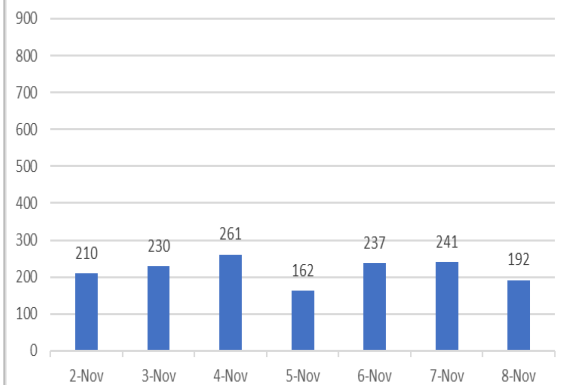

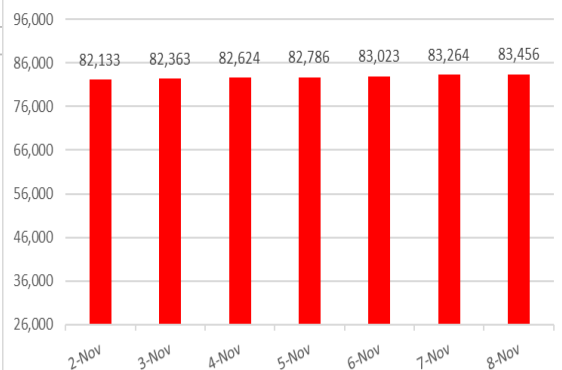
## HIGHLIGHTS

- Bahrain National Health Regulatory Authority confirmed accreditation of 19 hospitals, 4 factories and 307 licensed pharmacies by End of 2020.
- Al-Dhuhr (Noon) prayers were resumed in mosques; and the Jafferi Endowments Directorate is distributing health equipment and thermometers to mosques.
- Frontline medical care workers fighting against Covid-19 in Bahrain are immortalized by a famous Artist.
- Regional experts urged reopened schools, cafes and hotels to implement stricter protocols for water hygiene.
- Ministry of Education articulated that school principals continue to meet the educational objectives; and virtual classroom interactions of elementary students exceed expectations.

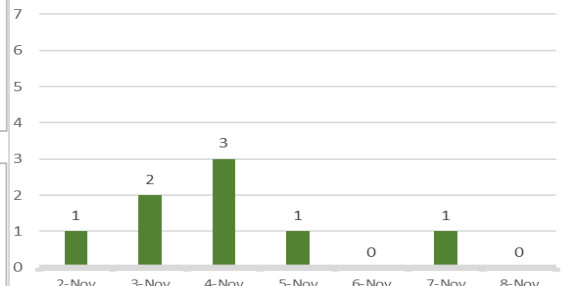
Number of New Cases
