Situation Report No. 25 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 8 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

• Approximately 52,800 tests were conducted.

• At present there are 341 active cases still receiving treatment, 3 of them are in critical condition, and 477 individuals were discharged.

• No new mortalities and no community transmission reported.

• Bahrain's government will spend \$570 million in salaries for 100,000 private sector workers from April to June to help alleviate the impact of the coronavirus outbreak.

• Bahraini government doubles the value of the social security pension which benefits 17,000 families and disability pension which benefits 12,000 person.

• Works Ministry to stop collecting rents from all tenants of municipal properties for three months.

Commercial, Industrial Activities to Resume Under Strict Conditions

• The Ministry of Health has produced a guide in different languages on the use of cloth face coverings to mitigate the spread of COVID-19.
