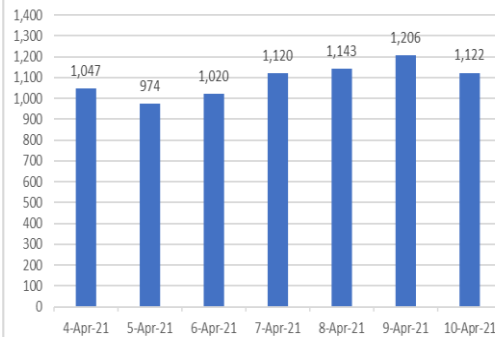

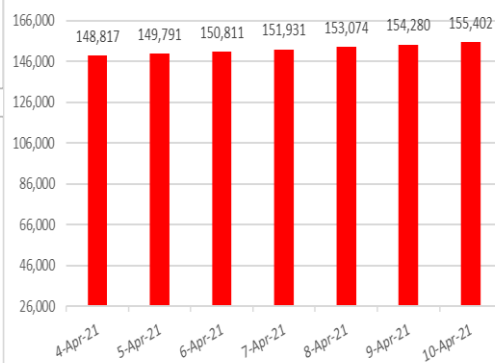
HIGHLIGHTS

- The Mortality were: 6 Bahraini citizens (5 Female (44, 54, 57, 64 and 81 years old) and 1 male (71 years old)) and 67 years old female expatriates.
- Increasing number of citizens and residents continue to take COVID-19 Vaccine in Bahrain; and Ministry of Health (MOH) revealed the total number of individuals vaccinated as of 10 April 2021 for the first dose (562,253) and for the second dose (376,815).
- MOH announced that prayers at mosques during the Holy Month of Ramadan will be strictly restricted to those who have recovered from Covid-19 or are 14 days past their second dose of valid vaccination.
- MOH: Citizens and residents have been urged to pick any available Covid-19 vaccine – and not wait for specific ones – as delays may put lives at risk.
- National Medical Taskforce for Combating the Coronavirus announced new/additional public health implementation measures commencing the first day of the Eid al-Fitr holiday.
- Ministries, governmental authorities and public institutions will be working from 8 am to 2 pm during the holy month of Ramadan.
- Registration for an appointment to receive the COVID-19 vaccination is done via either: The BeAware Application or by calling 444
- A one-year-old baby got infected 14 of her immunized family members with coronavirus last week.

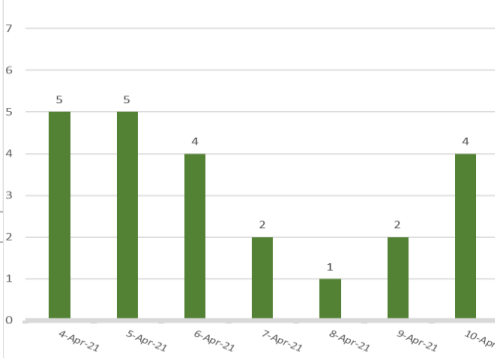
Number of New Cases
