## HIGHLIGHTS and USEFULL LINKS

### MOH

- There are currently 34 #COVID19 cases in a critical condition, and 18 cases receiving treatment. 1114 are stable out of a total of 1148 active cases
- The National Medical Taskforce for Combatting the Coronavirus (COVID-19) announces the booster dose interval has been reduced to one month after the second dose for high-risk individuals
- Demand for the age group from 12 to 17 years to take the anti-Coronavirus (Covid-19) vaccination in order to preserve their safety and the safety of all
- Call for elderly to take the initiative to take the booster dose for their own safety.. Dr. Al-Hajri: 80% of the total eligible population in the Kingdom of Bahrain have taken two doses of the anti-Coronavirus vaccination, equivalent to 67% of the total population
- The Minister of Health welcomes Dr. Tasneem Atatreh on the first day of officially assuming her duties as the first permanent Representative of the organization for the Eastern Mediterranean Region in the Kingdom

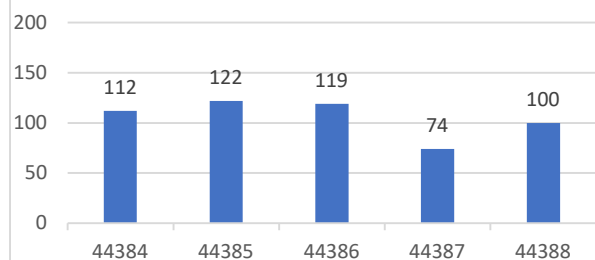

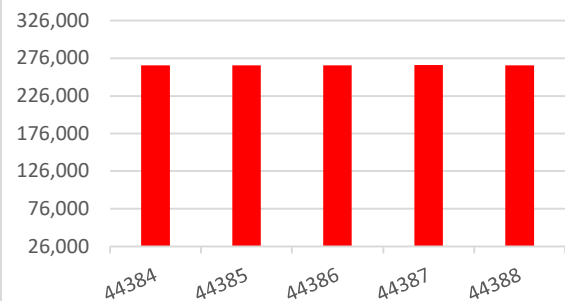

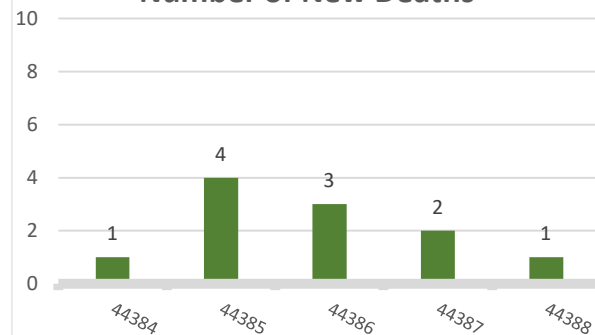
### Number of New Cases
