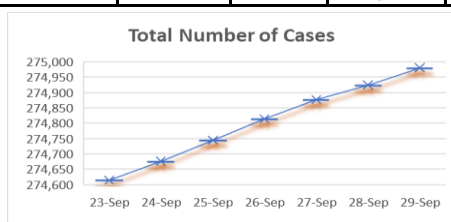
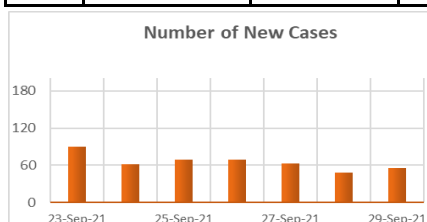

Fake face masks are seized in crackdown

Counterfeit face masks and thermometers were seized by inspectors from the local market, in a crackdown to help health authorities tackling the Covid-19 pandemic. Inspectors at the National Health Regulatory Authority (NHRA) also encountered the prevalence of devices sold with the promise of disinfecting the air around a person alongside unsubstantiated anti-coronavirus claims last year.

Crucial Covid studies carried out in Bahrain

Bahrain has published 23 crucial and ground-breaking studies on coronavirus (Covid-19) in the last 12 months outlining the country's successful pandemic policies, a senior medic has revealed. The list of research papers updated by the National Taskforce for Combating Covid-19 include 12 on clinical and treatment protocols of Covid-19, six on epidemiology and public health, three on Covid-19 vaccines and two on diagnostic topics. The analyses are published on regional and international scientific journals and platforms and could prove essential reading for other countries tackling the pandemic, as well as offer methodology and good practice guidelines to help tackle any future health crises.

Quarantine-free visa plan 'a success'

More than 90 Bahrainis have taken advantage of a quarantine-free visa agreement with Thailand. The 'Sandbox Programme' allows vaccinated travelers to visit specific areas without quarantining, as long as they remain in the designated area for seven to 14 days.
