

# Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)



## Situation Report No. 30 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 13 April 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 67,350 tests were conducted,
- Number of newly confirmed cases is 219, which is the single largest daily increase, bringing total to 1,355.
- At present there are 764 active cases, 4 of them in critical condition; 591 individuals were discharged.
- No new mortalities and no community transmission recorded.
- Gulf Air continues evacuating Bahrainis from countries with high COVID-19 spread.
- Bahrain will start clinical trials using convalescent plasma transfusion to combat the disease in currently infected patients.
- The vast majority of new cases affects expatriates who usually live in crowded accommodation.

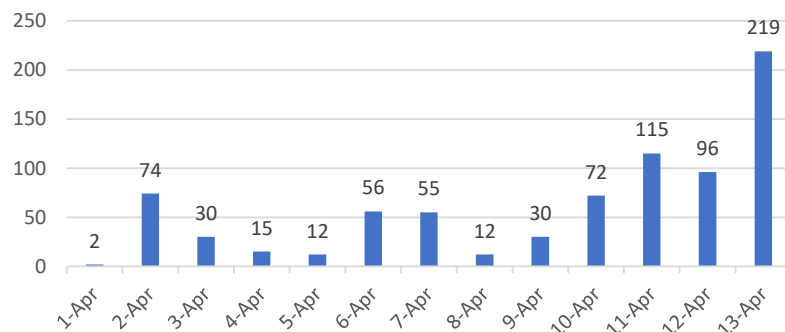
