Situation Report No. 36- Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 19 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 87,000 tests were conducted.
- 108 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 1,881.
- At present there are 1,112 active cases still receiving treatment, 2 of them in critical condition, and 762 individuals were discharged.
- No new mortality and no community transmission recorded.
- 19 suspects to stand trial for violating anti-coronavirus measures.
- The National Institution for Human Rights (NIHR) continued its field visits to the isolation, quarantine and treatment centres.
- Al Fateh Mosque will be opened for Friday prayers by the imam and only five people with the obligation to wear masks.
- WHO releases new guidance on safe Ramadan practices in context of COVID-19 (see link below).

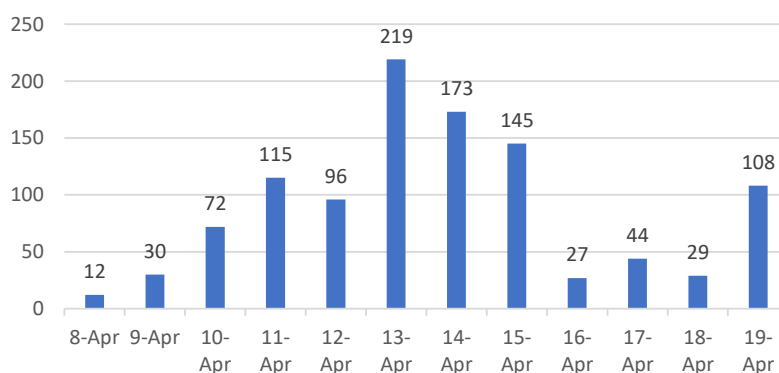
