Situation Report No. 44 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 27 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 117,800 tests were conducted.
- 76 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 2,723.
- At present there are 1,497 active cases still receiving treatment, 2 of them in critical condition, and 1,218 individuals were treated and discharged.
- No mortality and no community transmission recorded.
- 157 Bahrainis evacuated from Egypt as part of the repatriation programme.
- Bahrain Centre for Strategic, International and Energy Studies "Derasat" has published a report titled "Overview: The Use of Technology in the Coronavirus Crisis (COVID-19)".
- The textile department of the Ministry of Health manufactures masks to be distributed for free to the employees in the Ministry's building.
- WHO scientific brief discusses the role of measuring COVID-19 antibodies in understanding infection status/history, showing that there is no evidence that they protect from reinfection (see link below).

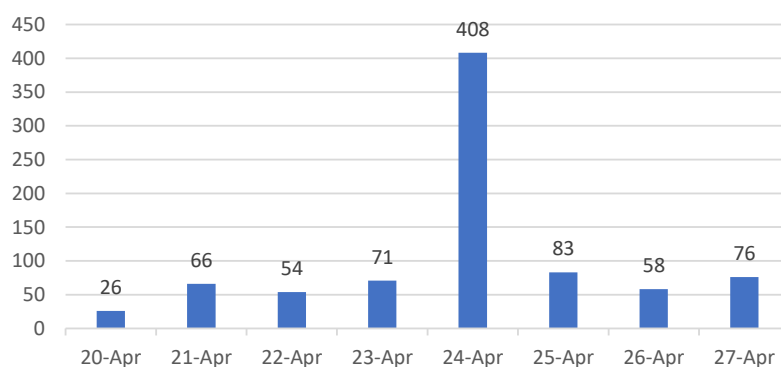
