HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 144,200 tests were conducted.
- 99 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 3,383.
- At present there are 1,657 active cases still receiving treatment, 1 of them in critical condition, and 1,718 individuals were discharged.
- No mortality and no community transmission recorded.
- Crown Prince Centre for Training and Medical Research: trained over 1,500 medical personnel to tackle the Corona virus.

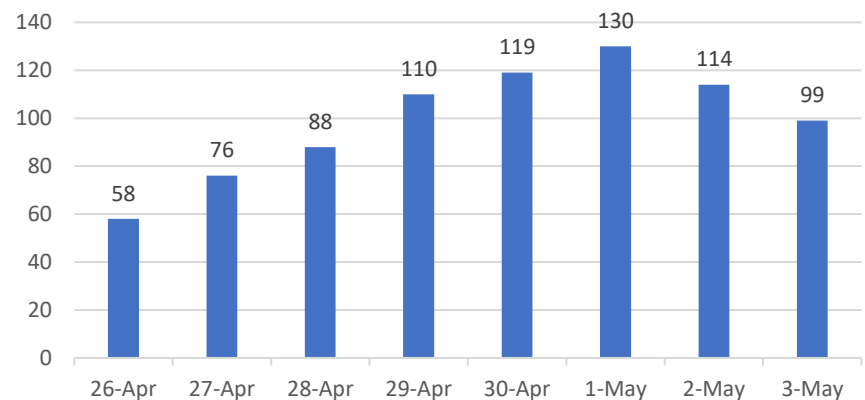
