Situation Report No. 52 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 09 May 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 178,400 tests were conducted.
- 840 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 4,774. 69% of new cases are expatriates.
- At present there are 2,711 active cases still receiving treatment, 2 of them in critical condition, and 2,055 individuals were discharged.
- No mortality recorded and no community transmission recorded.
- Coffee shop fined BD 9,000 for serving hookah
- Ministry of Health: 16 members of a Bahraini family were infected because of one of the family members due to non-compliance with the instructions.
- Bahrain continues to repatriate its citizens stranded because of disrupted intentional travel.

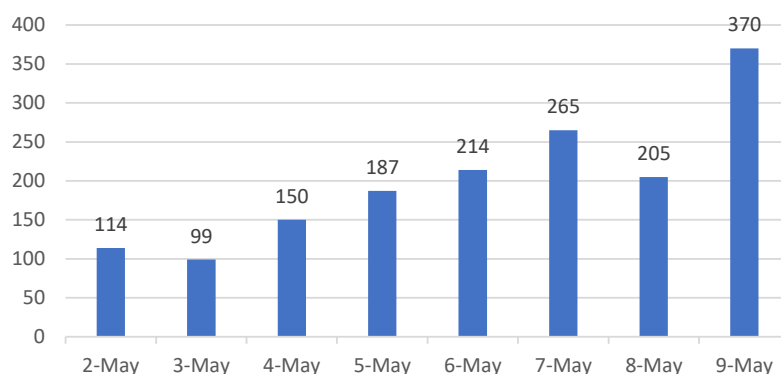
