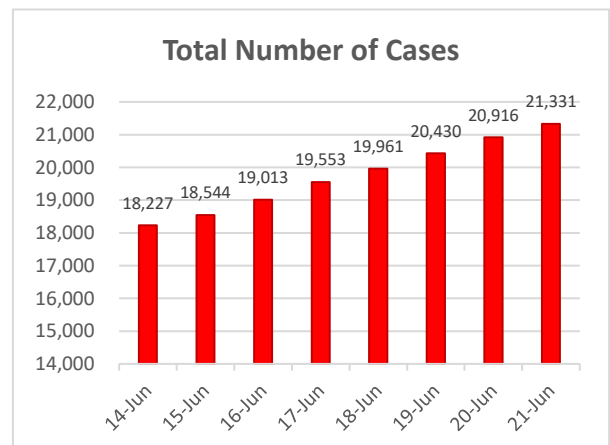
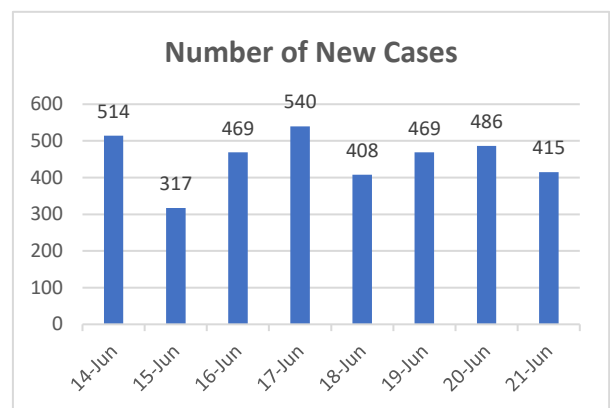

## HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortalities were 2 male Bahraini citizens (64 and 88 years-old) and 1 male expatriate (52 years-old).
