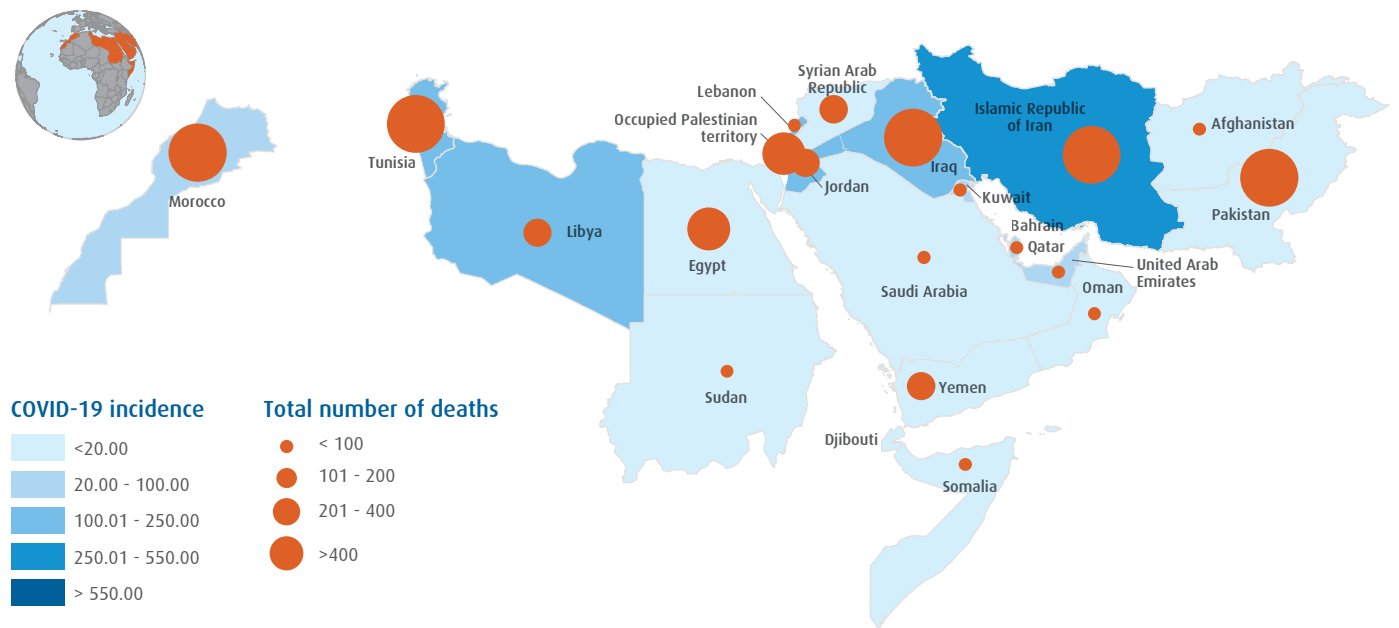

EPIDEMIOLOGICAL HIGHLIGHTS

- **COVID-19 cases and deaths:** As of 25th September 2021, the Eastern Mediterranean Region (EMR) has reported 15,662,684 confirmed COVID-19 cases and 287,118 deaths since the start of the pandemic.
- **Epidemiological trend:** during the reporting period, in comparison with the previous two weeks:
 - The number of reported cases has decreased by 34%
 - Deaths have decreased by 29%
 - Testing rates have stabilized
 - 4 and 6 countries have reported an increase in cases and deaths respectively.
 - A decrease in both cases and deaths was reported by 12 countries.
- **COVID-19 testing:** Total number of tests in the region has reached 230,491,106; median cumulative positivity ratio is 9.1% (range from 1.0% to 30.8%).
- **SARS-CoV-2 variants:**
 - 21 countries in the Region have officially reported the detection of the **Alpha variant of concern (VOC):** Afghanistan, Bahrain, Djibouti, Egypt, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Libya, Morocco, Oman, the occupied Palestinian territory, Pakistan, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Somalia, Sudan, Tunisia, the United Arab Emirates, and Yemen.
 - 18 countries in the Region have officially reported the detection of the **Beta VOC:** Bahrain, Djibouti, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Libya, Oman, Morocco, the occupied Palestinian territory, Pakistan, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Somalia, Sudan, Tunisia, the United Arab Emirates, and Yemen.
 - 6 countries in the Region have officially reported the detection of the **Gamma VOC:** Bahrain, Jordan, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Pakistan, Sudan, and the United Arab Emirates.
 - 16 countries in the Region have officially reported the detection of the **Delta VOC:** Afghanistan, Bahrain, Egypt, the Islamic Republic of Iran, Iraq, Jordan, Kuwait, Lebanon, Morocco, Oman, the occupied Palestinian territory, Pakistan, Qatar, Saudi Arabia, Tunisia, and the United Arab Emirates.

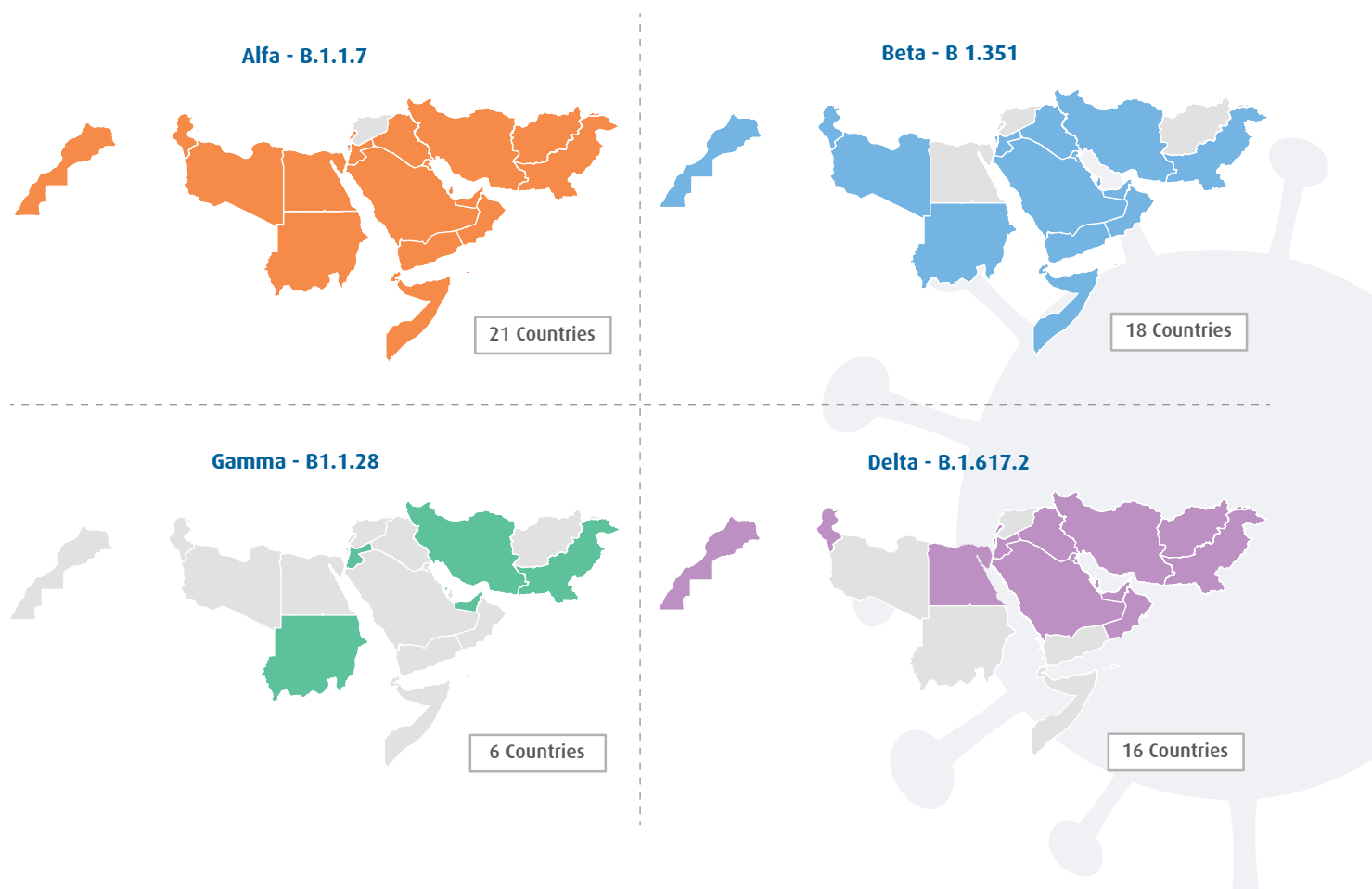

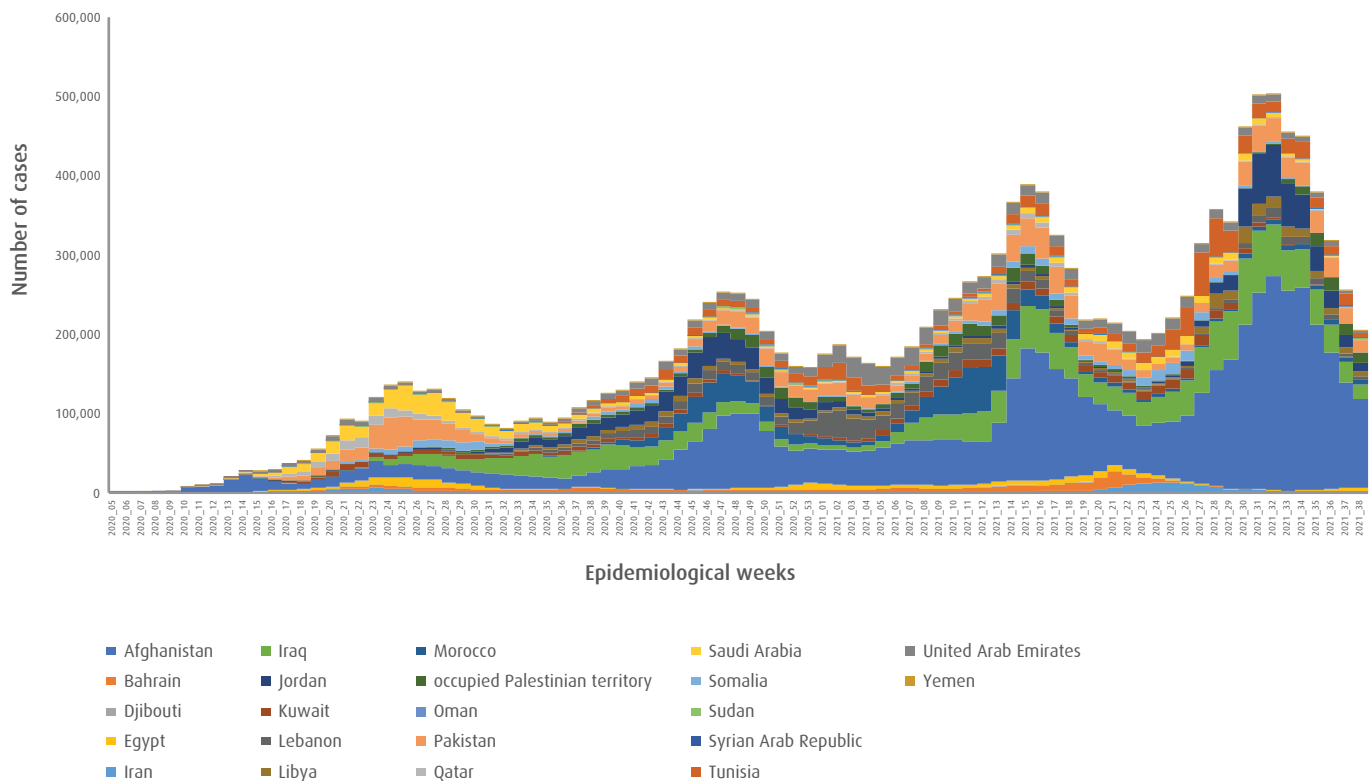

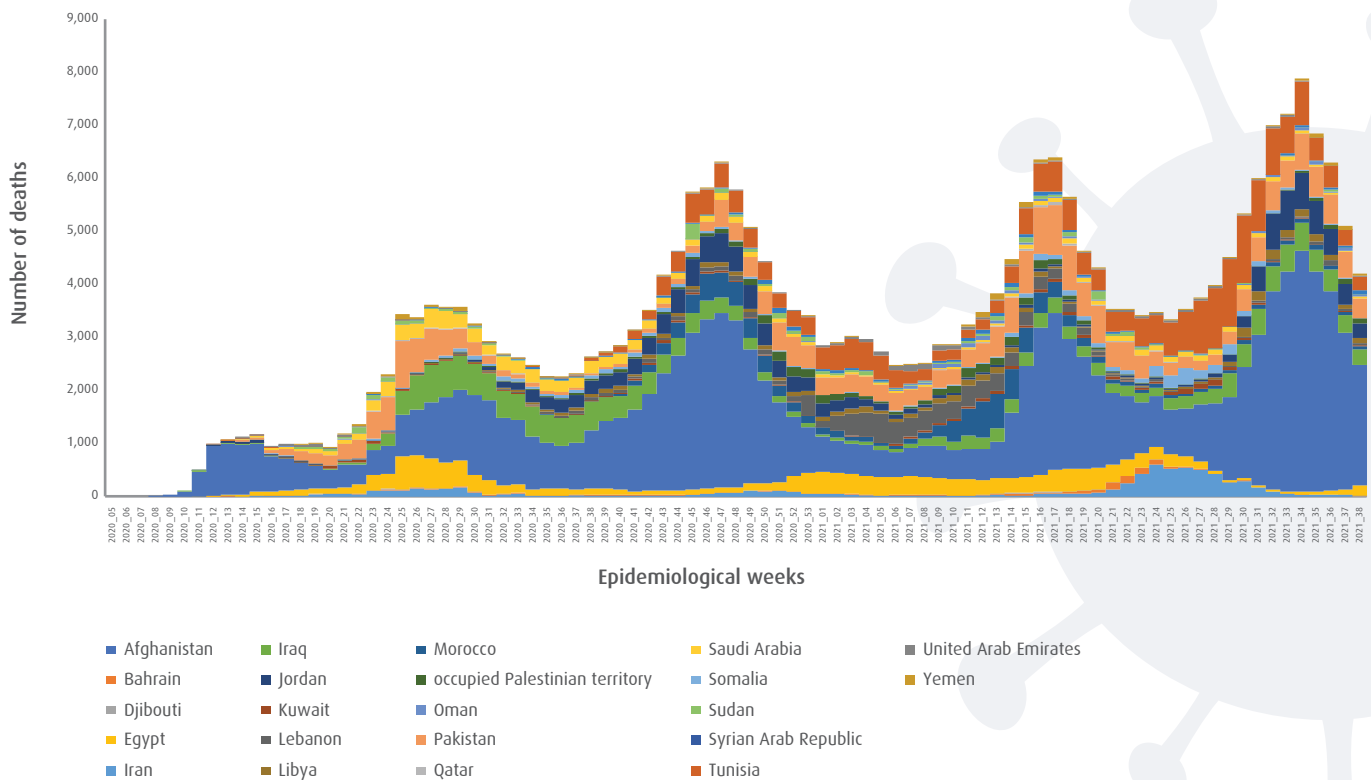
Graph 1: Weekly distribution of COVID-19 cases in the Eastern Mediterranean Region

REGIONAL RESPONSE HIGHLIGHTS

Operations Support and Logistics

- Dispatched medical supplies at more than US\$ 2.7 million value to support COVID-19 and non-COVID-19 health emergency responses during the reporting period.
- Coordinated the delivery of 30 tons of trauma and surgical supplies to Kabul, Afghanistan.

Health Operations and Technical Expertise

Clinical Management

- Conducted mission between 2-12 September to Yemen, focusing on:
 - Scaling up critical/ICU care training and oxygen/biomedical supply at national level.
 - Analyzing current issues and challenges in overall clinical management and operations.
 - Enhancing coordination between Oman and Yemen for a longer-term critical care training program as a twinning project.
 - Developing a fit-for-purpose oxygen scale up program for Yemen.
- Updated the WHO Living guideline for Therapeutics and COVID-19 (published 24 September 2021): <https://www.who.int/publications/i/item/WHO-2019-nCoV-therapeutics-2021.3>
- Coordinated allocation of Tocilizumab (IL-6 RB) for identified resource-limited countries.

Health Information Management and Surveillance

- Held a virtual training for the Ministry of Health in Iraq on the Epidemic Intelligence from Open Sources (EIOS) media scanning tool.

Research and Knowledge Management

- Reviewed proposals of vaccine effectiveness study.
- Revisited plans for continuation of sero-prevalence household surveys.
- Received Somalia's first case study which focused on use of research evidence in COVID-19 response as part of Network of Institutions for Evidence and Data to Policy (NEDtP) work.

COVID-19 Vaccine

- Monitored COVID-19 vaccine supply, utilization, and progress in vaccination coverage
- Attended the meeting with the Regional Director, consulted with WHO Representatives in countries with low vaccination coverage to review challenges and offer solutions.
- Reactivated country support teams for low performing countries.
