## Situation Report No. 47 - Kuwait

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 03 May 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

- 364 new cases, bringing total to 4,983. 69 of the new cases are nationals, and the remaining 295 are expatriates.
- 14 of the new cases are travel related, 348 are contacts of cases and 2 are under investigation.
- 5 new mortalities, all expatriates, age range 43-63 years.
- 3,169 cases remain under treatment, 72 of them are in ICU, out of those in ICU 29 are in a critical condition.
- Recovery of 73 cases bringing total to 1,776.
- No community transmission has been reported so far.
- Kuwait's MoI transfers citizen to mandatory quarantine for breaching home quarantine.

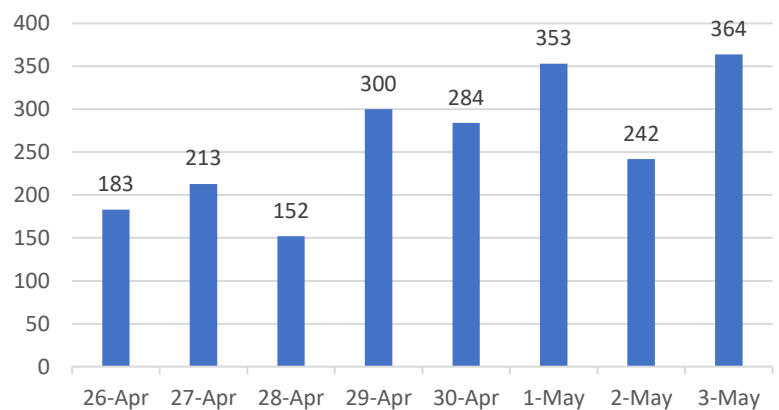
