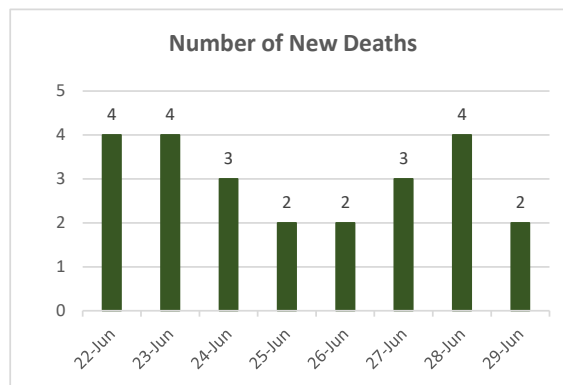
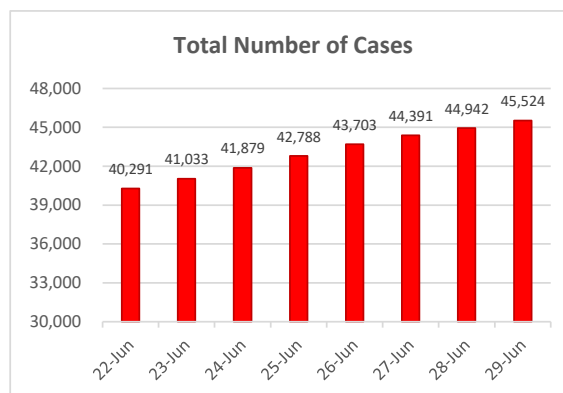
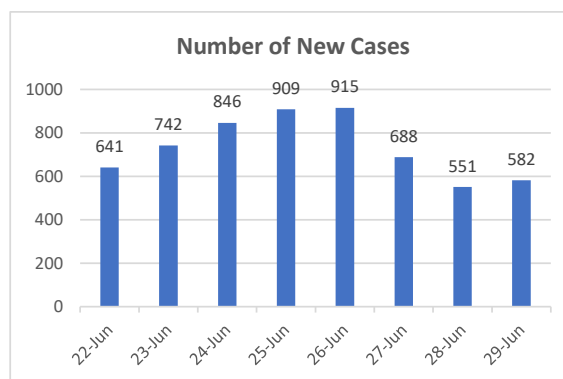

HIGHLIGHTS

- Of the new cases, 319 (54.8%) are nationals.
- New infections by health area: Al Ahmadi (158), Al Jahra (136), Al Farwaniyah (115), Hawally (88) and Capital Area (85).
- Repatriation of residency violators in shelters almost complete.
- 3-stage plan to restart commercial flights in Kuwait Airport starting from August 1, 2020.
- Kuwait pledges \$100m for global efforts against COVID-19.
- 26,400 illegal expatriates left the country without paying fines under the amnesty programme.
- 157 advertisement board "Dispose off Mask in Designated places" in all governorates for public awareness.
- WHO updates criteria for releasing patients from isolation (see link below).
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages.
- WHO clarifies comments made earlier regarding COVID-19 transmission, See link below.
