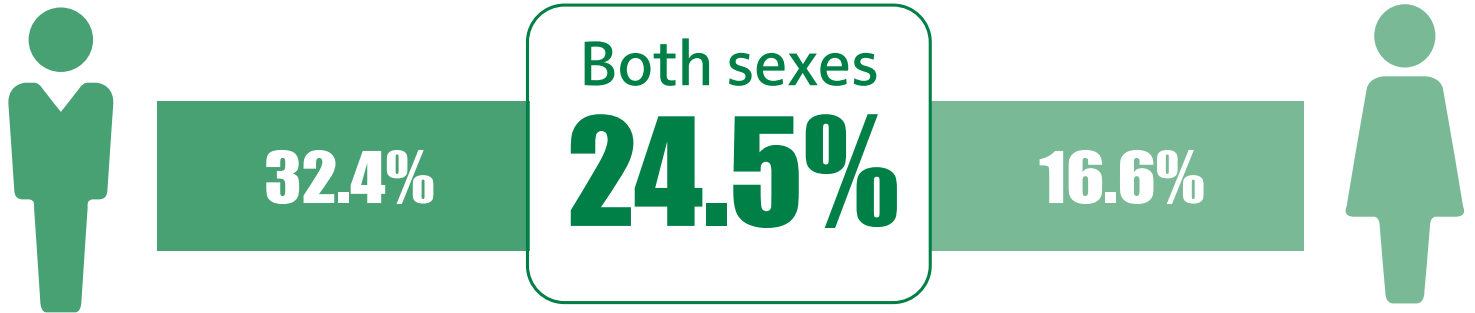




# JORDAN SURVEY OF NONCOMMUNICABLE DISEASE RISK FACTORS 2019 (JORDANIANS AND SYRIANS)

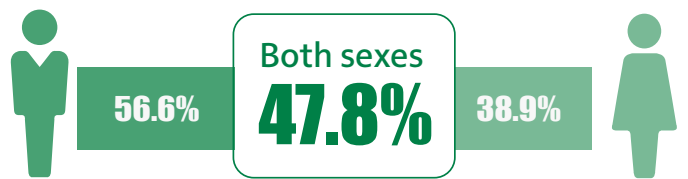
## Cardiovascular disease (CVD) risk

Adults 40–69 with a 10-year CVD risk  $\geq 30\%$ , or with existing CVD

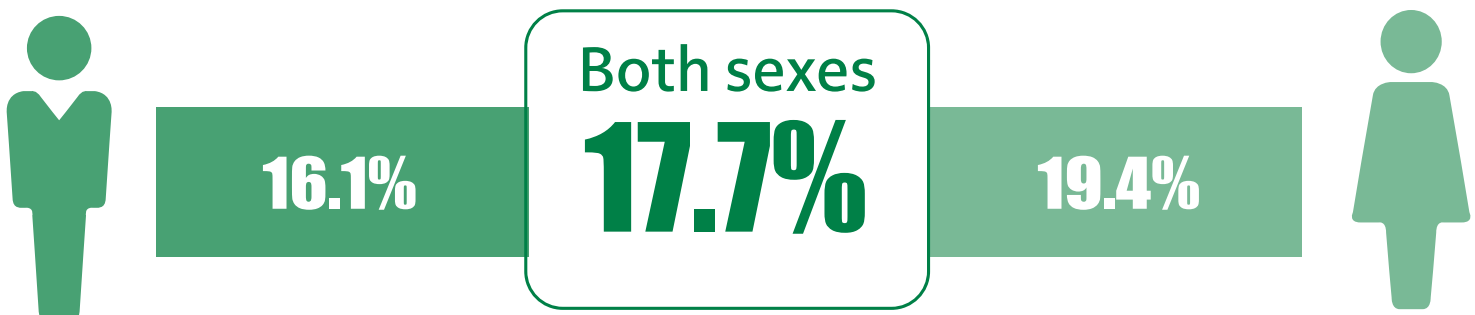


Raised BP (SBP  $\geq 140$  and/or DBP  $\geq 90$  mmHg) who are currently on medication for raised BP

Raised BP (SBP  $\geq 140$  and/or DBP  $\geq 90$  mmHg) who are not currently on medication for raised BP



Raised total cholesterol ( $\geq 5.0$  mmol/L) who are currently on medication for raised cholesterol
