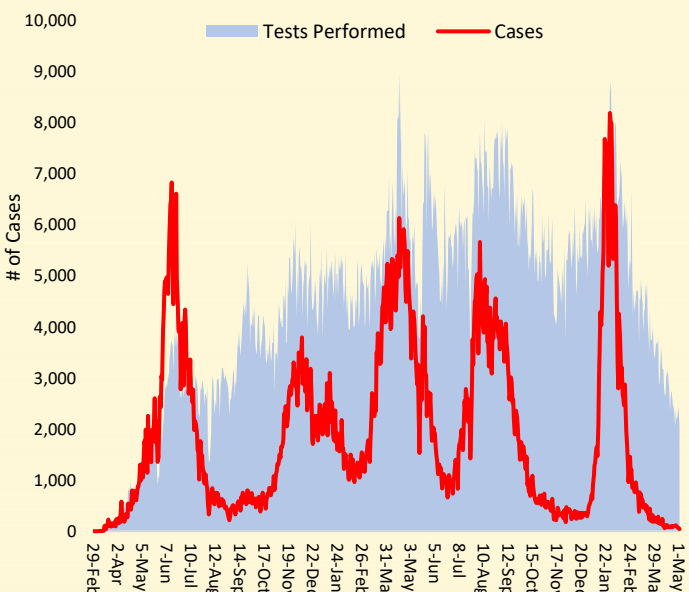

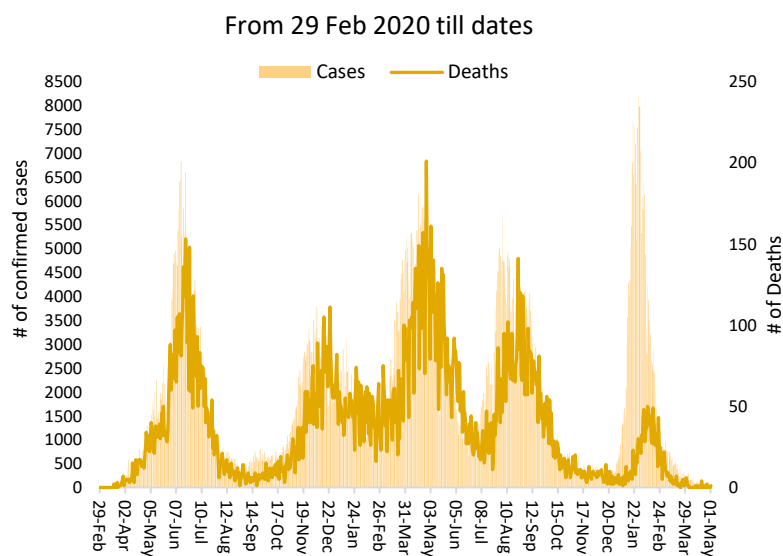


On 2nd May 2022, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala met with UNICEF Country Representative in Pakistan, Ms. Aida Girma-Melaku to discuss the upsurge in cases of Acute Watery Diarrhea in Karachi. During the meeting, Dr Palitha briefed Ms Aida on the current situation of AWD and the WHO support to Department of Health Sindh.

WHO support includes support to awareness campaign in the community, provision of ORS and Aqua tabs in highly affected districts of Karachi, establishment of Cholera sentinel surveillance sites, water quality testing, case management and establishment of Acute Watery Diarrhea control cell.

Ms Aida appreciated the WHO's support and timely interventions and pledged to work with WHO and Department of Health Sindh to alleviate this situation.
