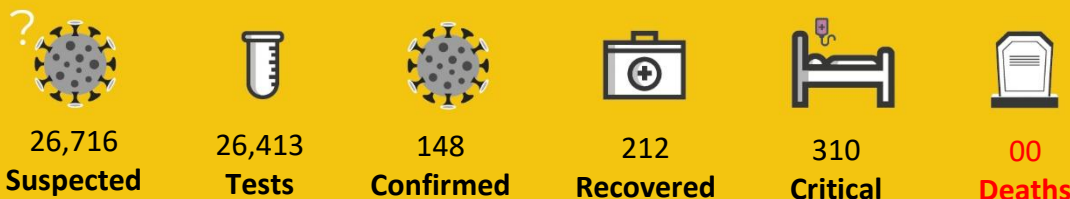

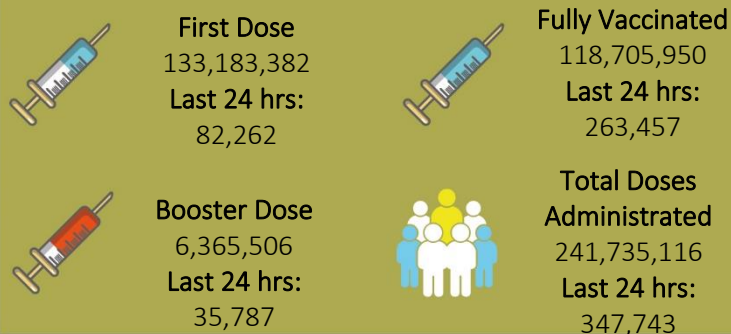
PAKISTAN SNAPSHOT (LAST 24hr)



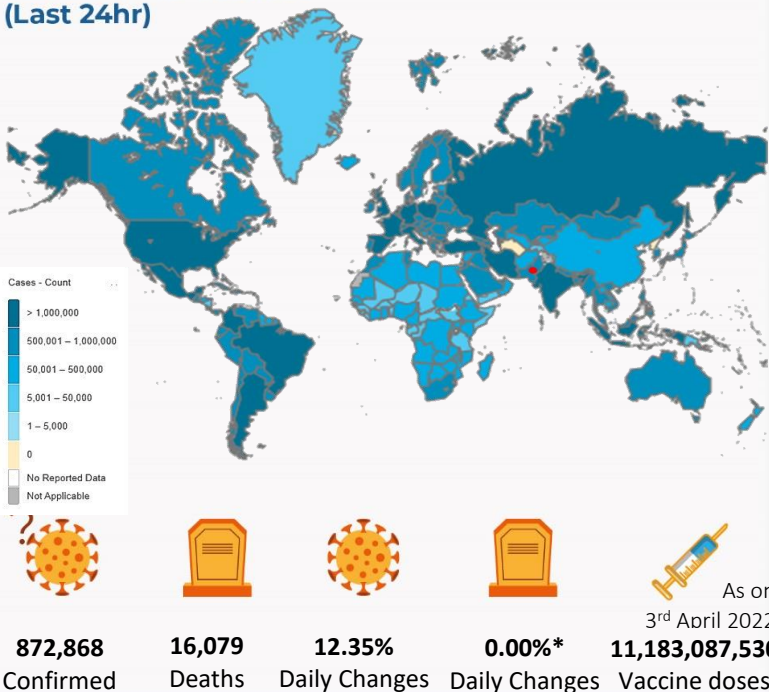
PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)



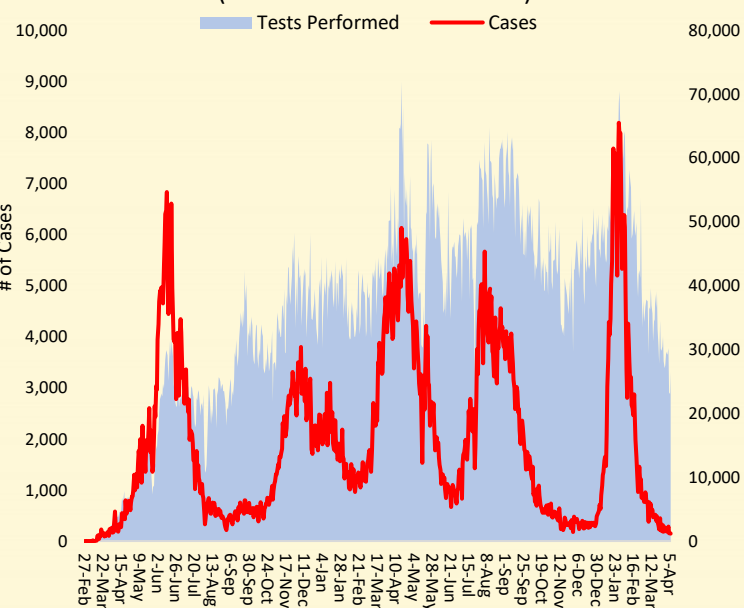

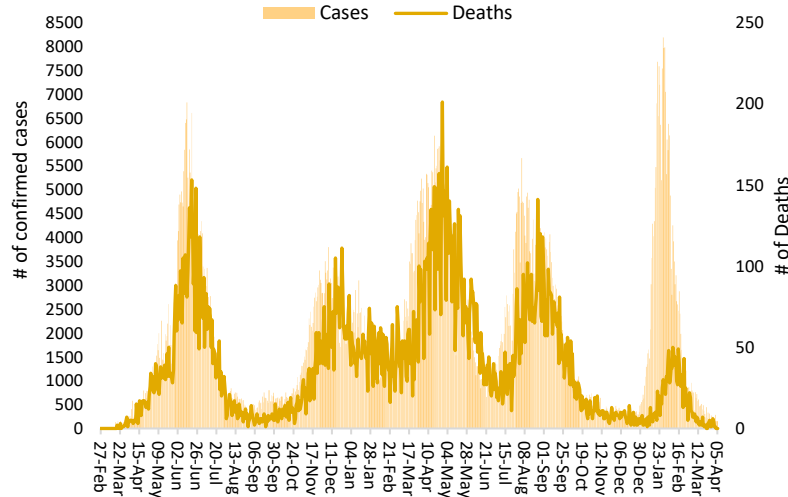
