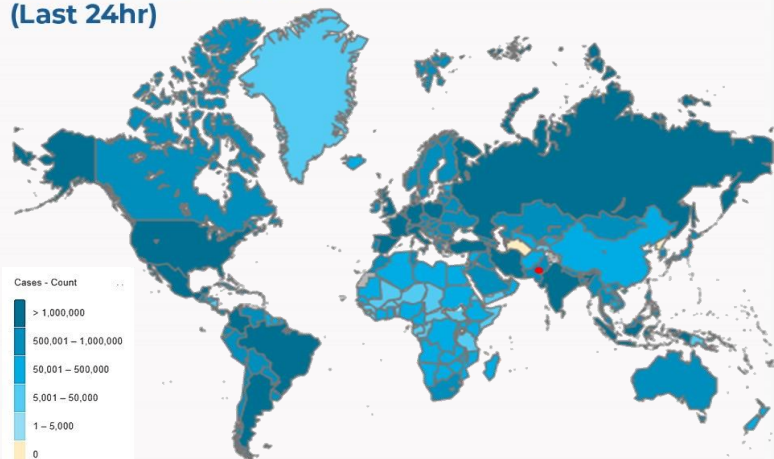

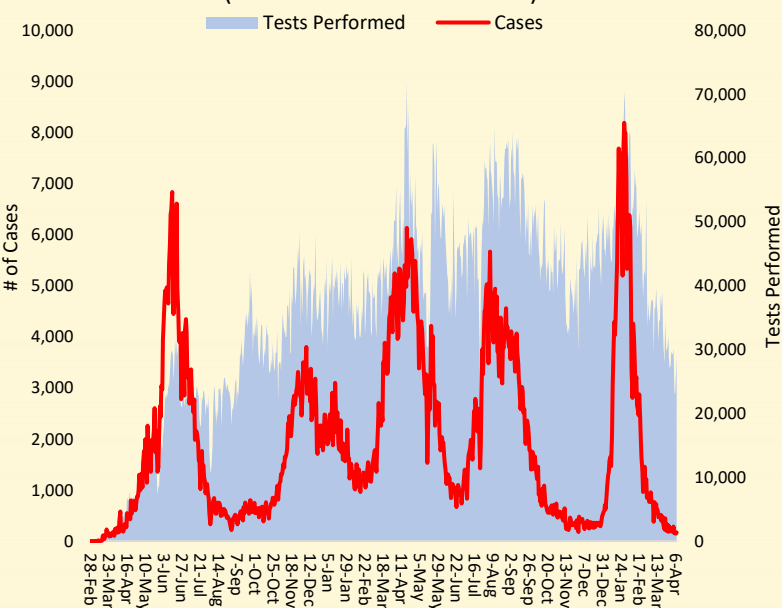

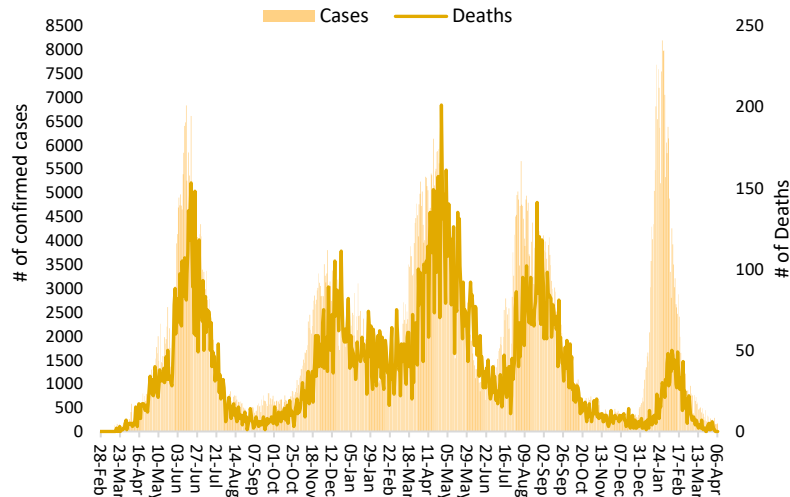
On 4th April 2022, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala met with Honorable Minister for Health Gilgit Baltistan (GB) H.E Mr. Haji Gulbar Khan at the Regional Headquarter Hospital Gilgit. After the meeting, Dr Palitha handed over 2 vans for medical outreach, 10 motorbikes for rescue 1122, 1 mini ambulance for medical referral and assortment of medical equipment. In attendance were the Secretary Health GB Mr. Sana Ullah, Regional Director Health Services Gilgit Dr Muhammad Iqbal, Provincial Director TB Control Program Dr Shah Zaman among others.

In his speech, Dr Palitha briefed the Minister on WHO's current support to the Government in strengthening COVID-19 response and thanked the leadership of GB for their response efforts.
