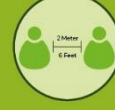

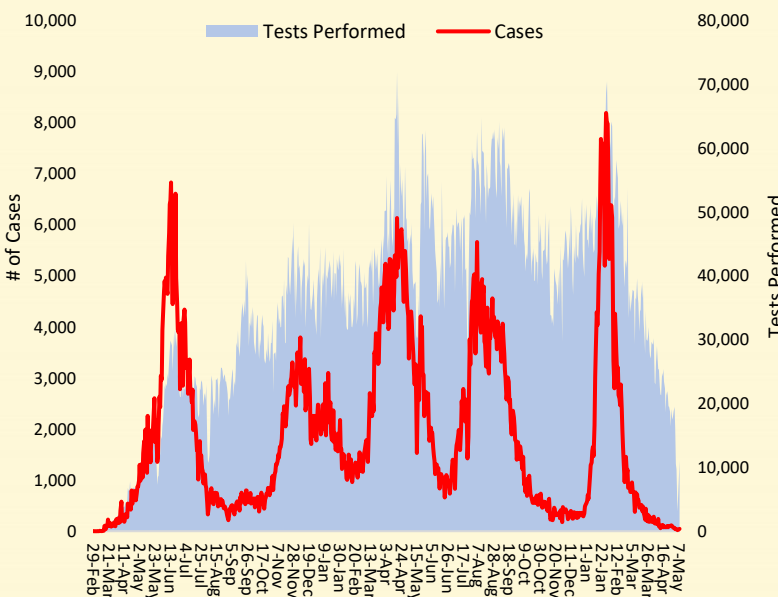

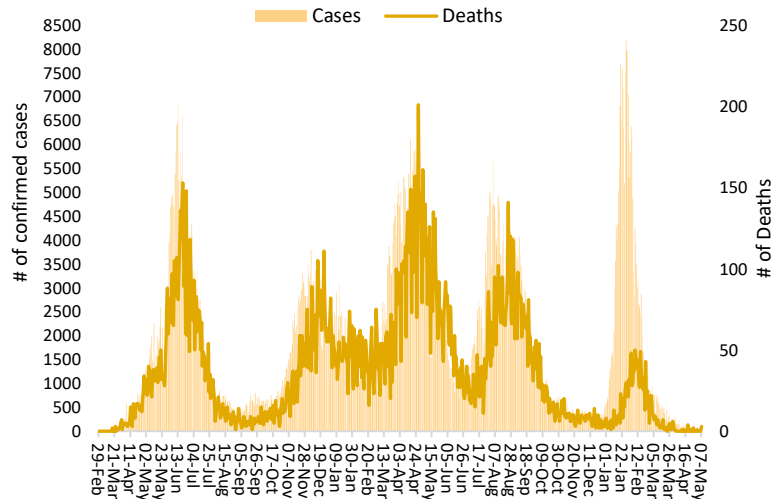

On 6th May 2022, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala chaired a meeting between WHO and UNICEF Pakistan at WHO country office. Chief of Health Dr Hari Banskota, Chief of WASH Mr Haile Gashaw, Chief of Field Operations Mr Scott Whoolery and Chief of Social & Behavior Change Communication Mr Jonathan Shadid from UNICEF and WHO-WHE team lead Dr Michael Lukwiya and NPO Surveillance Dr Musa Rahim from WHO Pakistan attended this meeting. This meeting was convened to discuss the current situation of Acute Watery Diarrhea outbreak and to determine the roles and responsibilities of WHO and UNICEF to support the Government in responding the outbreak. Both organizations agreed to collaborate closely to support the government and form a steering committee that included technical staff from both organizations. Moreover, WHO will be responsible for case management and disease surveillance and UNICEF will be responsible for the WASH component, including water quality monitoring while the RCCE activities will be coordinated jointly. The UNICEF delegate appraised WHO's initiative and pledged to work with WHO to support the government.
