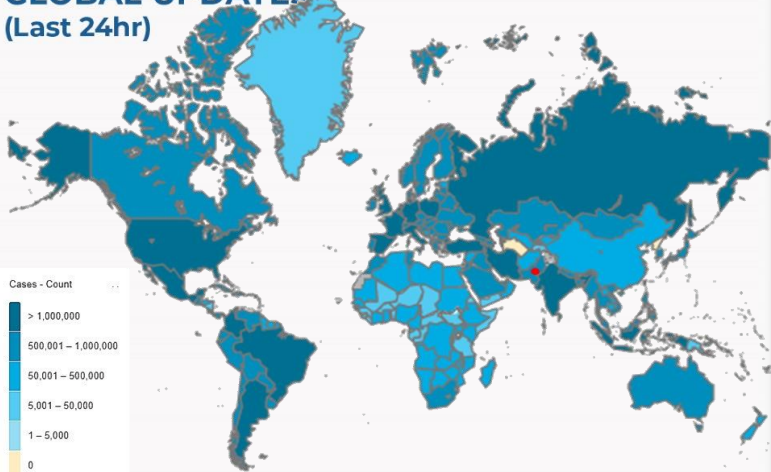

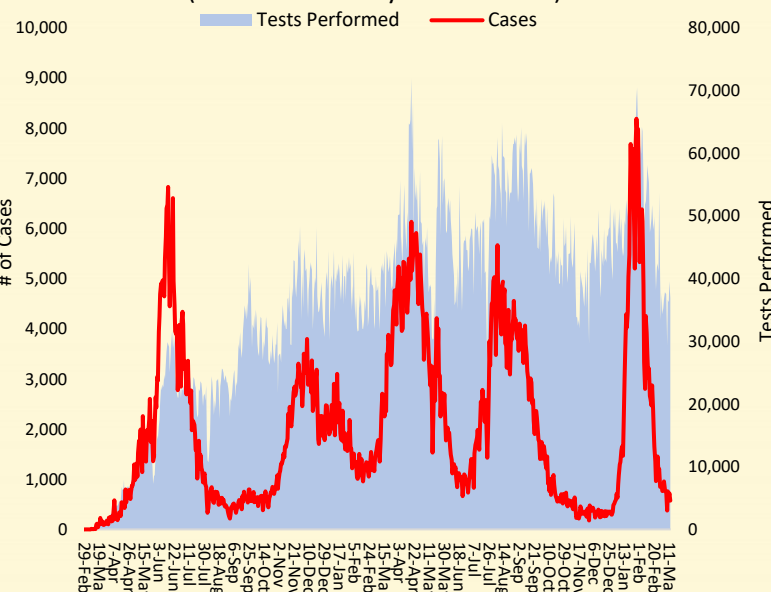

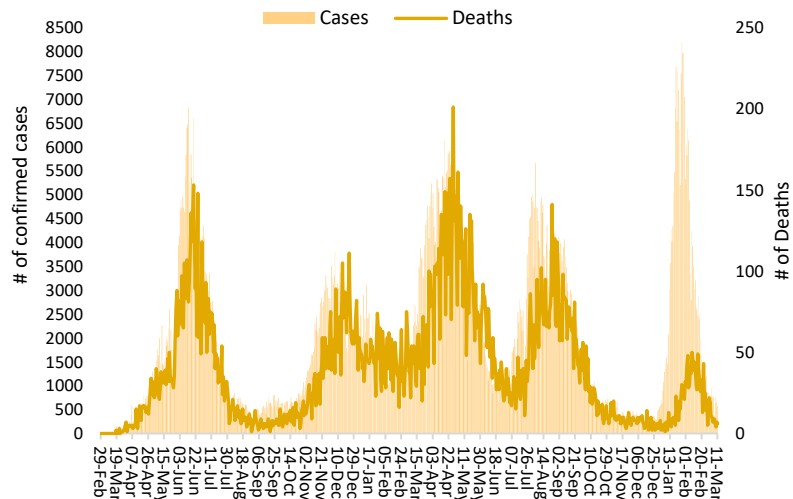


On 11th March 2022, The WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala met with the Honorable Minister of Health and Population Welfare Sindh Province, Dr Azra Fazal Pechuho at provincial EOC Sindh office Karachi. The objective of the meeting was to discuss the current COVID-19 situation with emphasis on phase 1 COVID-19 vaccination outreach campaign and maternal and perinatal death surveillance. Dr Azra also briefed the WR on Sindh Government efforts to enact and implement reproductive health rights legislation.

During his response, the WR praised the effort of Sindh Government in controlling COVID-19 and extended WHO support to further strengthen COVID-19 response and establish strong health care systems in the province. Dr Azra expressed appreciation for the technical and financial support being provided by World Health Organization.
