The Federal Expanded Program on Immunization (EPI) in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan, conducted National Review Meeting from 12th to 14th January 2022 at Pearl Continental hotel Lahore. Special Assistant to Prime Minister Dr Faisal Sultan graced the closing ceremony. The National Program Manager EPI Dr Akram Shah, WHO National Professional Officer EPI Dr Unaiza Hadi, provincial heads of immunization program and UNICEF technical staff also attended the closing session.

The objective of the meeting was to discuss the performance of EPI in 2021, identifying priority areas and to define immunization roadmap for the next five years in the country.

Dr. Faisal in his closing remarks highlighted that the EPI Program had a universal role in key health initiatives in 2021. He said, that "EPI program not only recorded a major coverage boost itself, but it also rendered great support to the achievement of COVID-19 vaccination targets". Dr Faisal Sultan appreciated the technical and financial support of WHO Pakistan for the EPI Program in the country
