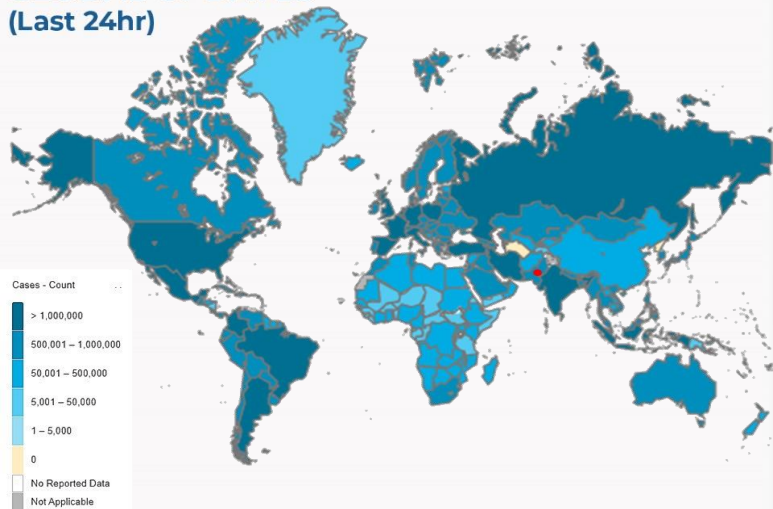

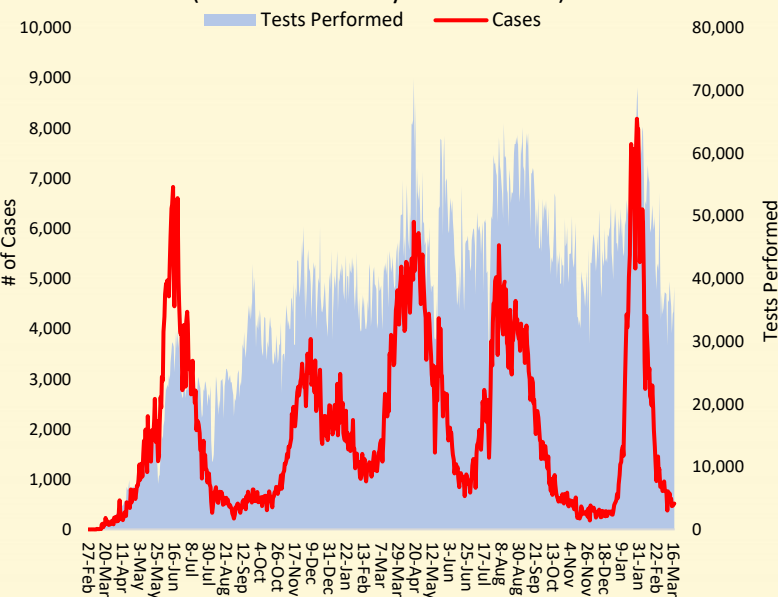

## Meetings & Coordination

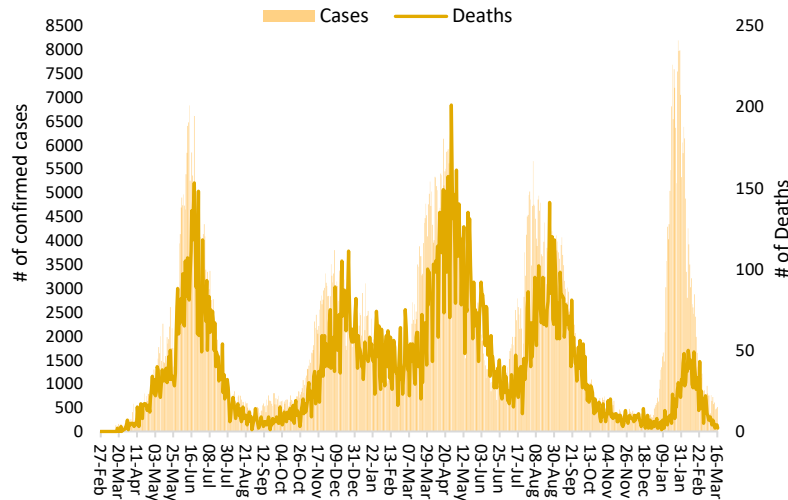


On 17th March 2022, The WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala along with Executive Director, National Institute of Health Prof. Dr. Maj. Gen. Aamer Ikram inaugurated a “COVID-19 Sample Collection Center” at NIH, Islamabad. The facility was refurbished with support from WHO and equipped with desktop computers, printers, chairs, tables, air conditioners, and a generator.

In his speech, Dr Palitha appreciated the Government of Pakistan's efforts in the COVID 19 response. He noted that the facility would be in position to support other infectious diseases outbreaks. Dr Aamer thanked WHO for the Technical and logistical support in the COVID-19 response in Pakistan and further stated that the refurbishment and inauguration of the COVID-19 Sample Collection Center is an addition to the great collaboration between WHO & NIH.
