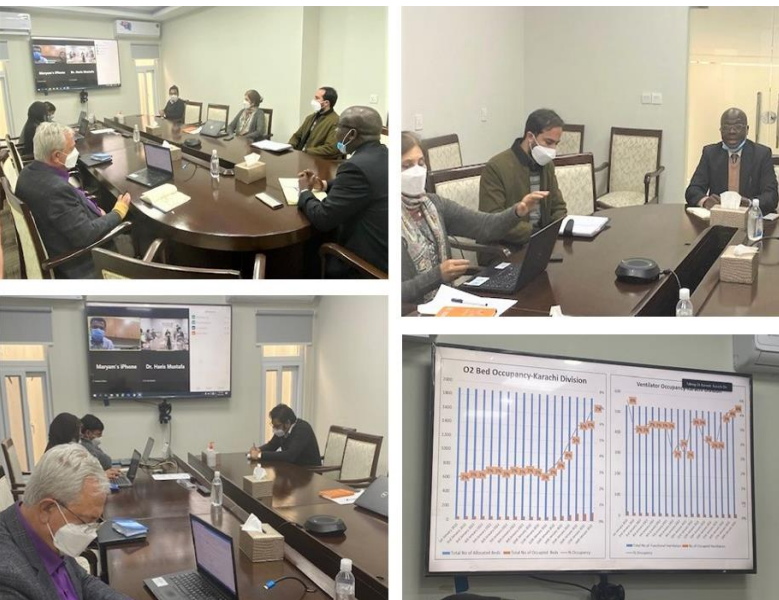

On 18th January 2022, WHO Country Office Pakistan held a virtual meeting with WHO Sub-Office Sindh. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the current upsurge of COVID-19 cases, particularly in Karachi. The WHE Team lead in Pakistan Dr Michael Lukwiya chaired the meeting.

WHO Sub-office Sindh team led by Head of Office Dr Sara Salman briefed on the current situation of COVID-19 in Karachi and the government response. It was noted that the daily incidence and bed occupancy is showing upward trend from the beginning of January 2022.

In his remarks, Dr Michael emphasized on continued WHO support particularly in Surveillance, Laboratory, Infection Prevention and Control (IPC), Community mobilization and sensitization, vaccination, and reinforcement of public health measures to control further spread of the infection. He called upon the sub-offices to support the province in updating response plan.
