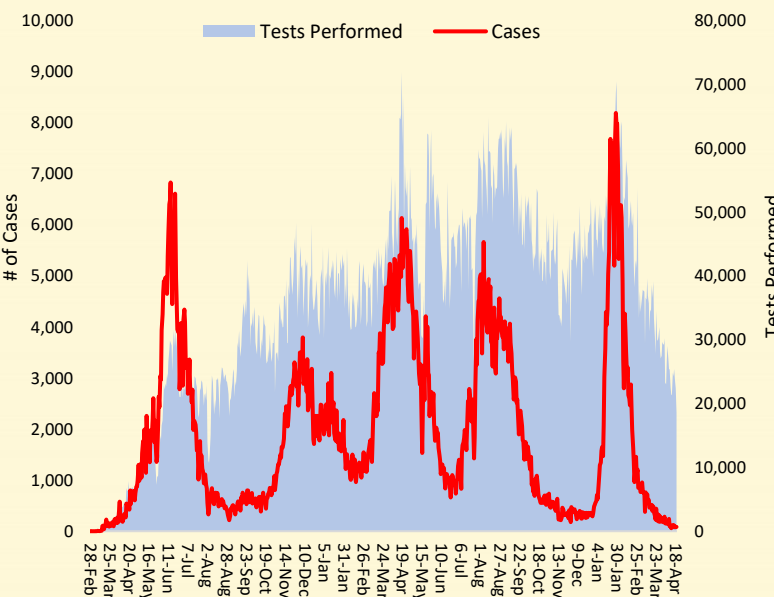

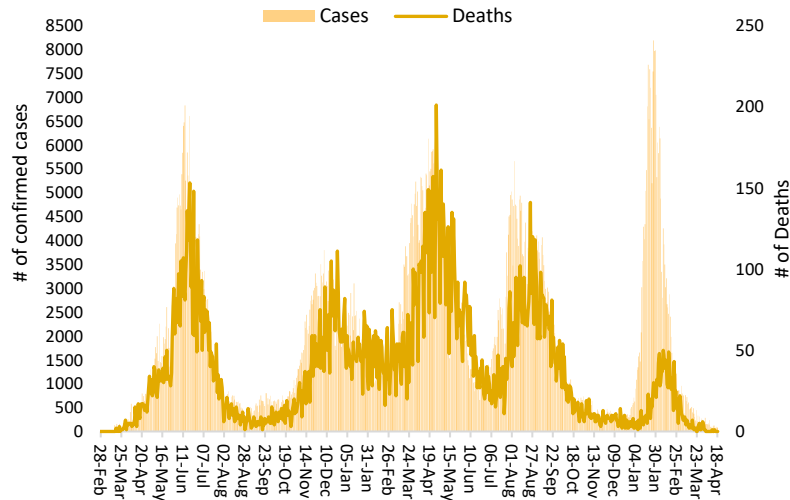
On 18 April 2022, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr. Palitha Mahipala met with the Dean Pakistan Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS) Dr. Rizwan Taj and District Health Officer ICT Dr Zaeem Zia at WHO Country Office Islamabad. The meeting was crowned with handover of telemedicine equipment meant to strengthen Integrated Health Services on Gender Based Violence (GBV) at Primary Health Care (PHC) facilities in ICT.

In his remarks, Dr. Palitha noted that strengthening health systems through innovations such as telemedicine is key in enhancing access to health services.

The DHO ICT appreciated WHO's support and collaboration and noted that the equipment will enhance provision of basic and advanced health care provision especially for psychosocial support, mental health, and referral services associated with GBV.
