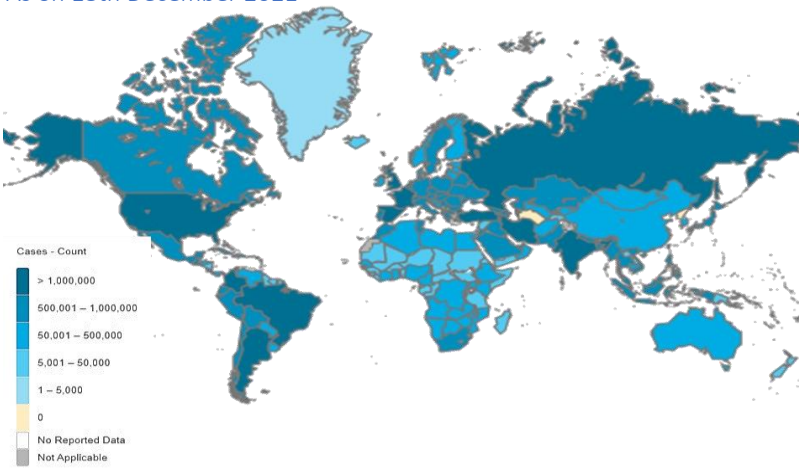


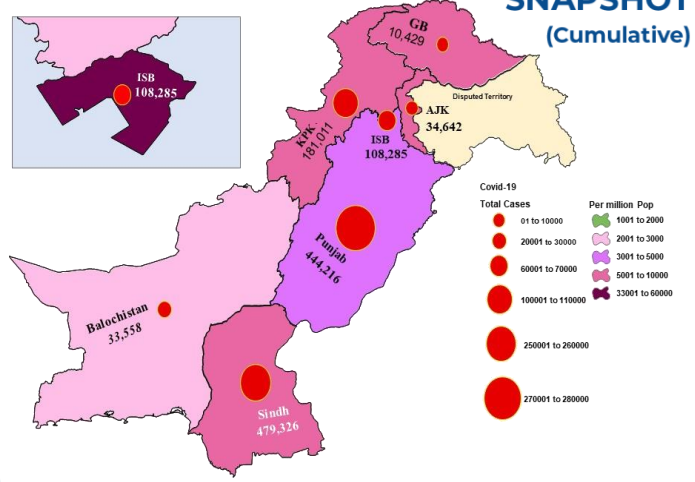

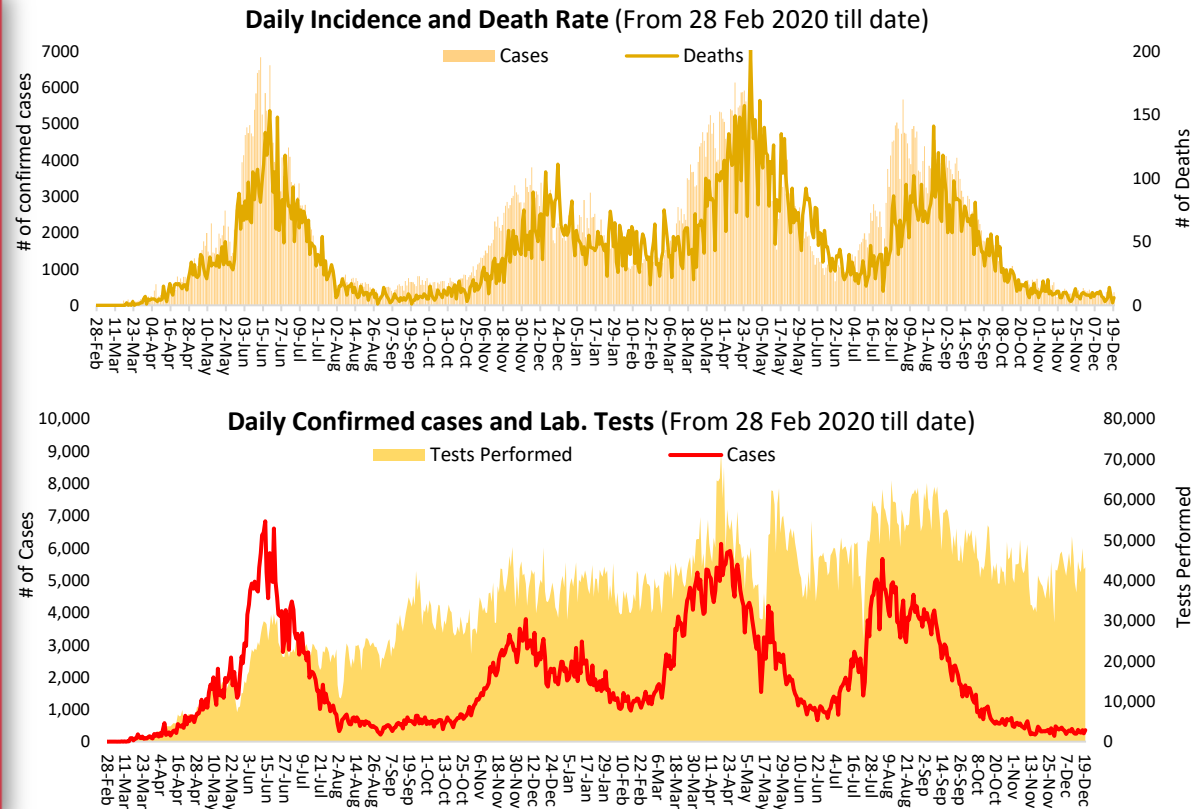

On 18th December 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala visited the Provincial Disease Surveillance and Response Unit (PDSRU) at Gilgit. Coordinator PDSRU and COVID-19 Response Dr Abdul Salam welcomed WR. Additional Secretary Health, Gilgit Baltistan Mr Muhammad Azam Khan, the WHO team members in GB and PDSRU team also attended the meeting. The current COVID-19 Situation in the region was discussed in the meeting.

Dr Palitha appreciated the Gilgit Baltistan Government efforts for implementation of the response measures. WR also highlighted the joint efforts of WHO and partners and reiterated the need for further strengthening collaboration with the Government on COVID 19 response. He directed the WHO team to identify possible areas of support to the PDSRU Gilgit.

Mr Azam Khan thanked Dr Palitha and appreciated the technical support of WHO. The two officials agreed to further enhance collaboration to support the health programs in GB.
