On 21st December 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala and Health Minister AJK, H.E Mr Nisar Ansar Abdali inaugurated a high-quality Kangaroo Mother Care (KMC) Center and MNCH Training Center at the Divisional Headquarter Teaching Hospital, Mirpur AJK. The Center has been jointly established by World Health Organization Pakistan and MNCH Program, AJK. District Health Officer Mirpur Dr Fida Hussain, Regional Director MNCH Program AJK Dr Farhat Shaheen and Medical Superintendent DHQ Hospital Mirpur Dr Farooq Noor attended the event.

Dr Palitha Mahipala in his remarks encouraged the clinicians to promote KMC for all premature and low birth weight babies to improve newborn survival. He anticipated efficient utilization of the newly established centers for improving quality of care for mothers and newborns in AJK.

Mr Nisar Abdali, acknowledged the support from WHO Pakistan for emergency response including earthquake, avalanche, and COVID-19 pandemic besides the support for establishment of KMC center and MNCH Training center. He reiterated Government of AJK commitment for uplifting the healthcare delivery system.
