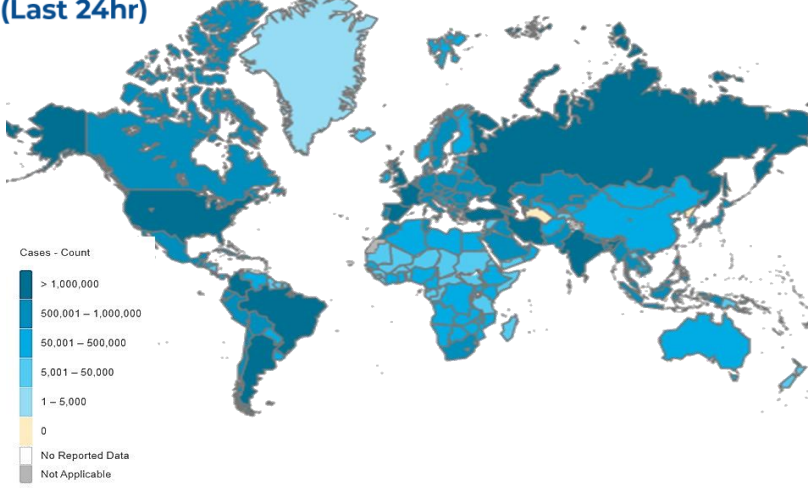
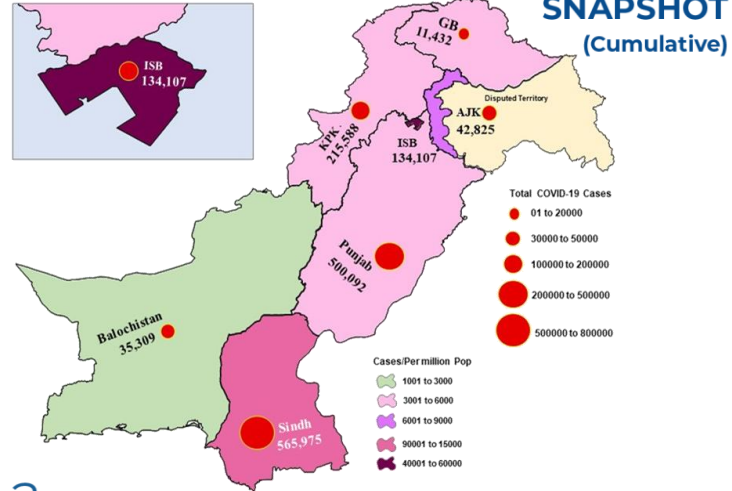

PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)



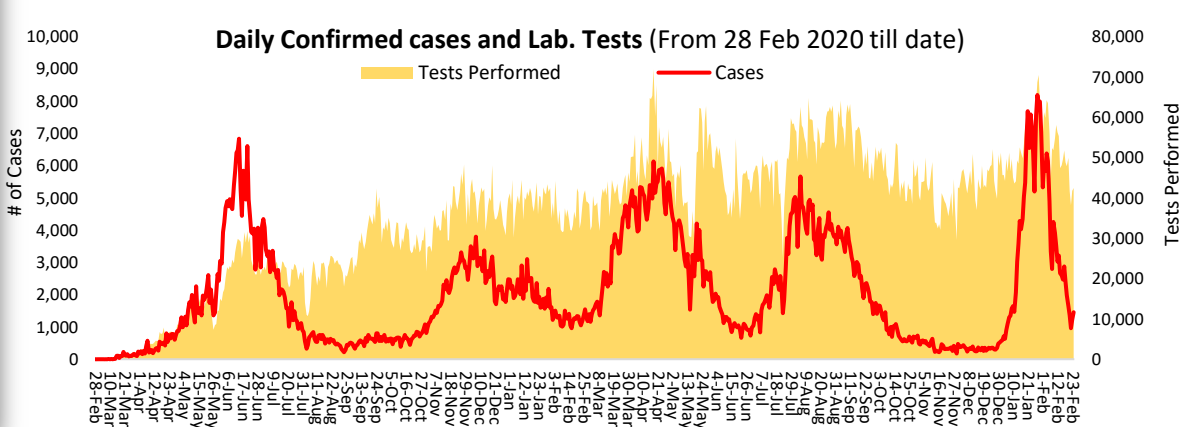
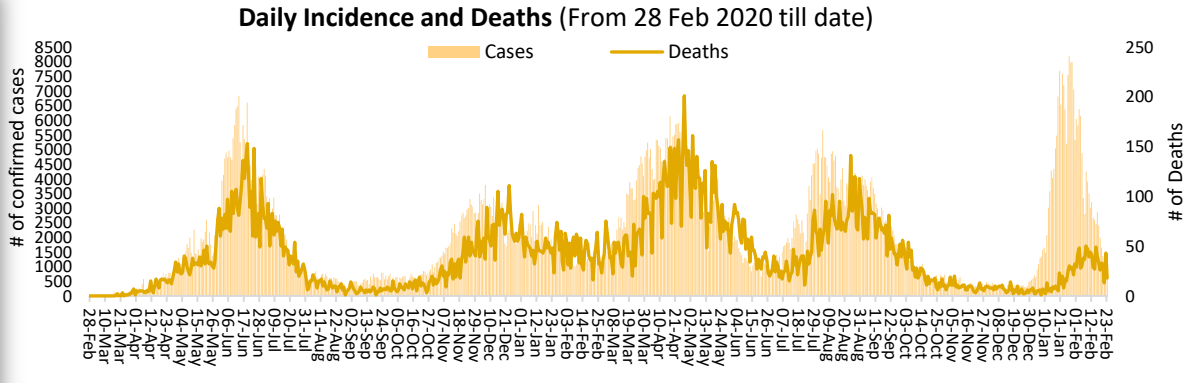

On 24th February 2022, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala, handed over 31 mini ambulances, 14 cold chain Trucks, 70 motorbikes ambulances for 1122, (332) motor bikes for sample collection, two 4x4 ambulances, (8) Double cabin vehicles, (2) COVID-19 vaccination vans and assortment of medical equipment and medicines to the Ministry of National Health Services Regulation and Coordination. The donation is aimed at strengthening the health system to provide more robust and effective response to COVID-19 pandemic and provision of essential routine health services. The handing over ceremony took place at the WHO Country Office in Islamabad. Federal Minister of Health H.E Dr. Faisal Sultan graced the occasion. Honorable Regional Director for WHO Eastern Mediterranean Region, Dr. Ahmed Al Mandhari joined the ceremony virtually. Secretary MoNHSR&C Mr Khawaja Amir Ashraf, Executive Director NIH, Maj. Gen. Aamir Ikram, the Dean of the Diplomatic Corp, United Nations Resident Coordinator, Ambassadors, diplomates, and representatives of development partners attended the event. In his speech, Dr Palitha expressed appreciation to the Government of Pakistan for its efforts, and thanked donors and partners for their timely support to the people of Pakistan. Dr Faisal Sultan praised WHO Pakistan for their continuing support throughout the COVID-19 pandemic and acknowledge WHO's commitment to strengthen the health system in Pakistan.
