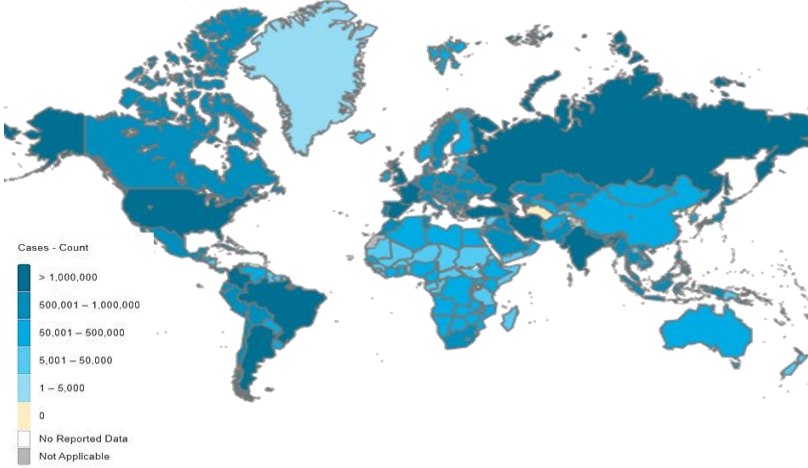




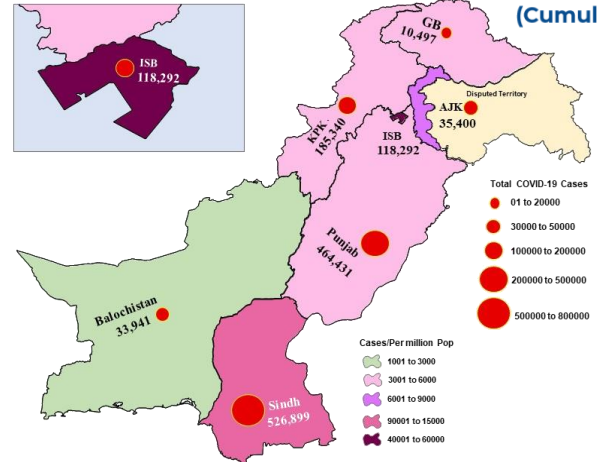

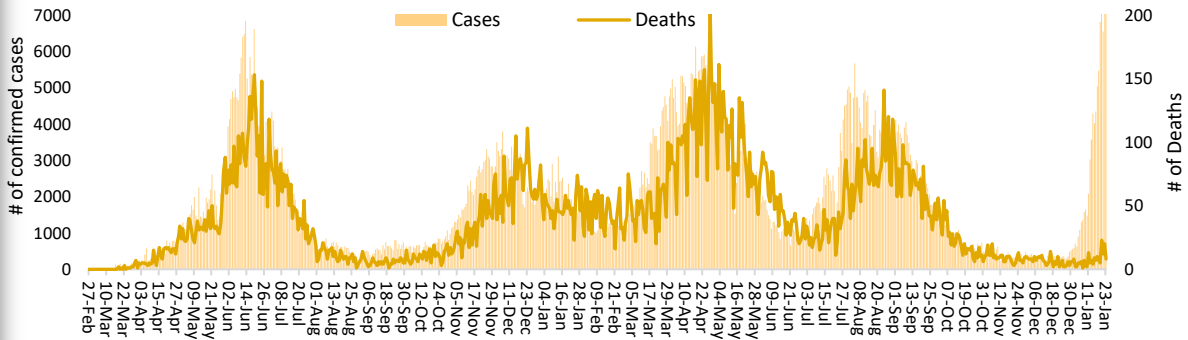

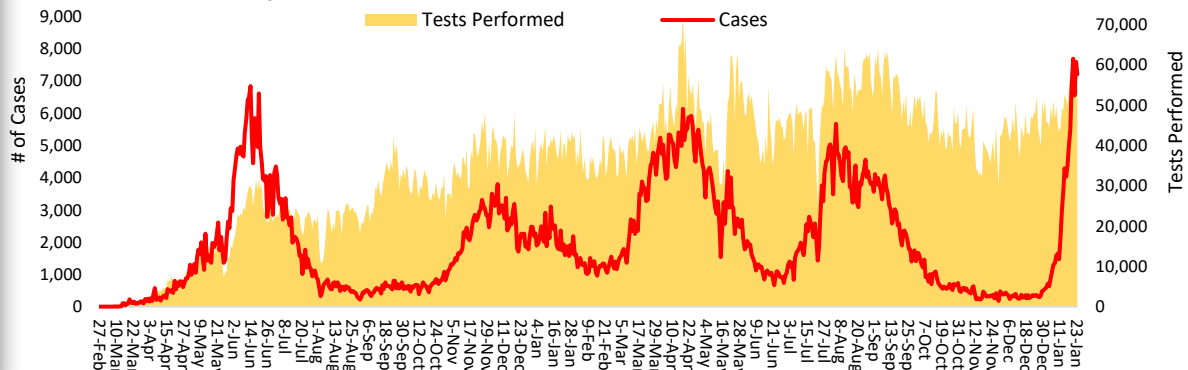

On 21<sup>st</sup> January 2022, WHO Country Office Pakistan Acting In-charge Dr Michael Lukwiya met with the Director Public Health, Global Health Development / Eastern Mediterranean Public Health Network (GHD|EMPHNET) Dr Magid Al Gunaid, Chief Disease Surveillance, National Institute of Health Dr Jamil Ansari, and Program Officer, GHD|EMPHNET Mirza Zeeshan Baig. The meeting took place at WHO Country Office Islamabad.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss areas of collaboration between GHD|EMPHNET and WHO in Pakistan. During the discussion, the officials agreed to enhance the collaboration on Integrated Disease Surveillance and Response (IDSR), Risk Communication and the Health Cluster.

Dr Jamil appreciated the support of WHO Pakistan and development partners for strengthening the disease surveillance and other IHR core capacities in Pakistan.
