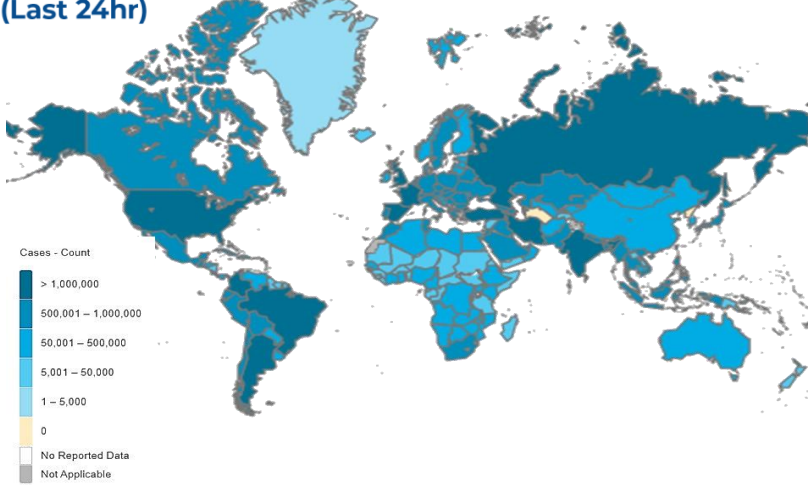
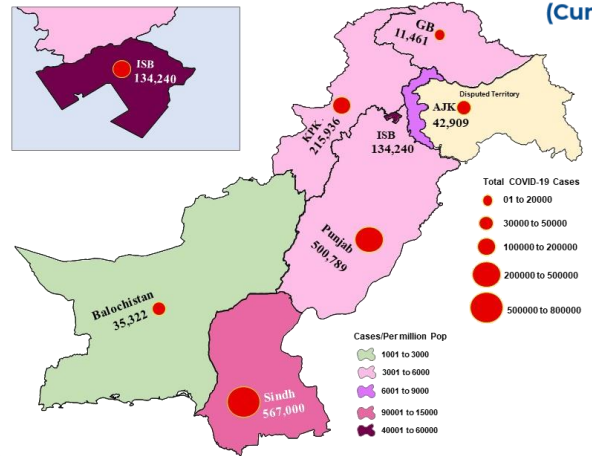

PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)



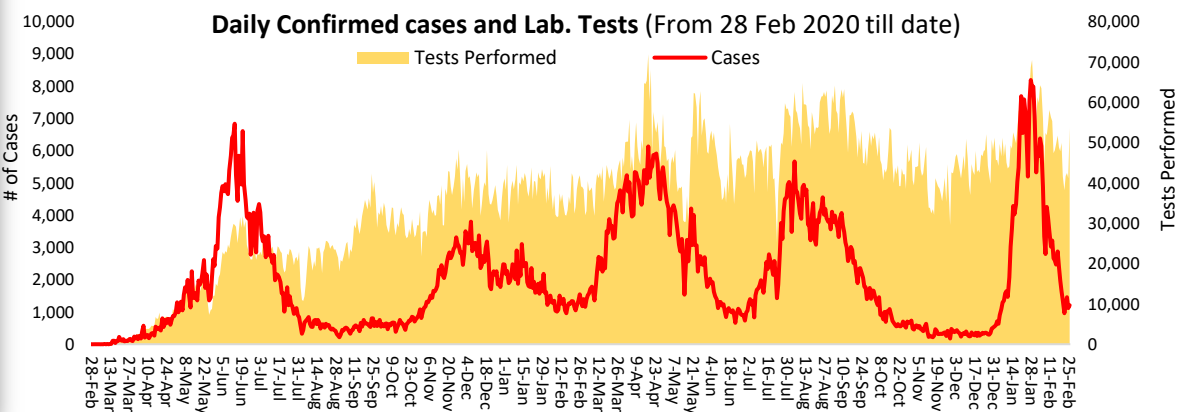
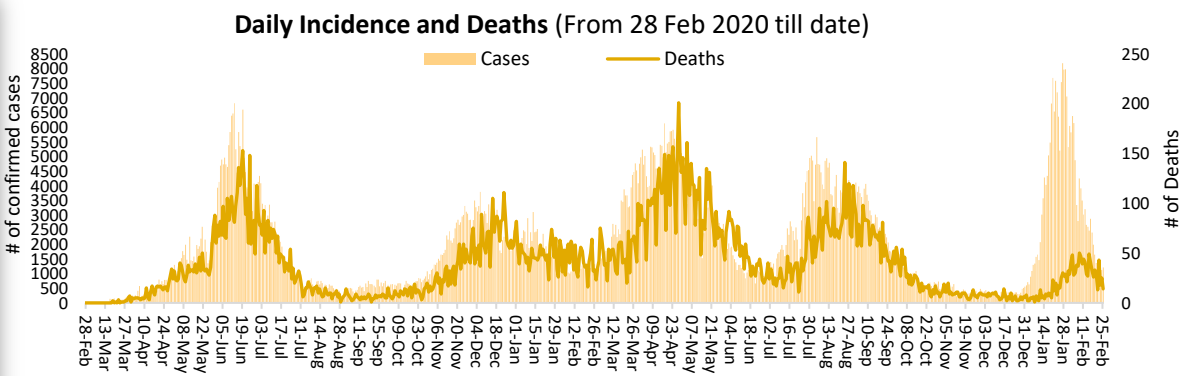

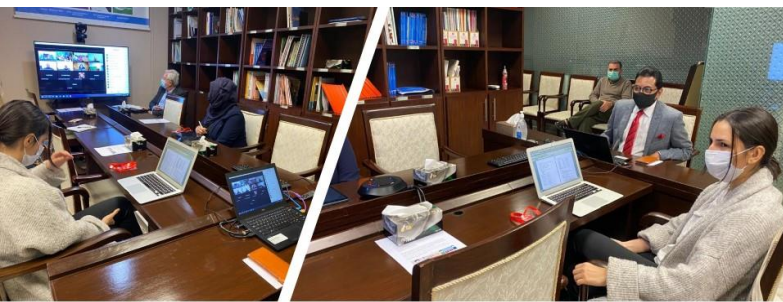

On 26th February 2022, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala convened the third health sector partners meeting at WHO country Office Islamabad. The virtual meeting was attended by National and International NGOs, UNICEF and UNHCR.

During the meeting, a presentation was made by Dr Mahipala on the current COVID-19 situation at the global, regional, and national levels and WHO actions to contain its spread. He also apprised them on WHO's support to Afghan refugees in Pakistan for vaccination and provision of essential healthcare and urged partners for collaboration to deliver a synergistic and comprehensive response and to avoid duplication of efforts.

The UNHCR and partners discussed their interventions with Afghan refugees and their host communities.

As part of his closing remarks, Dr Palitha expressed his thanks to all partners for their remarkable support of marginalized communities and reiterated his strong commitment to supporting Pakistan's efforts to strengthen the health system and provide essential health services for vulnerable populations and Afghan refugees.
