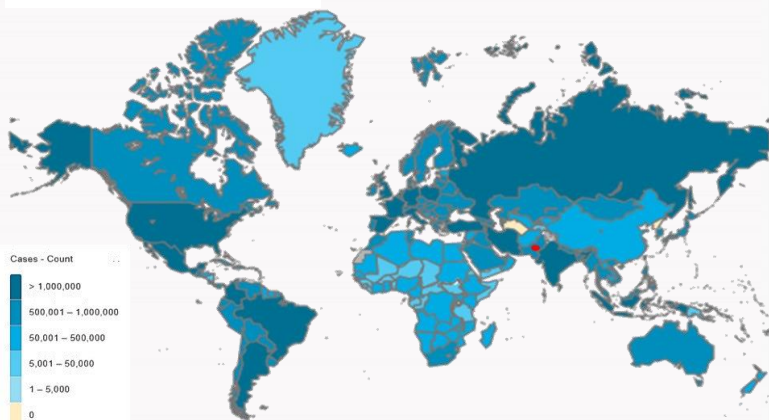

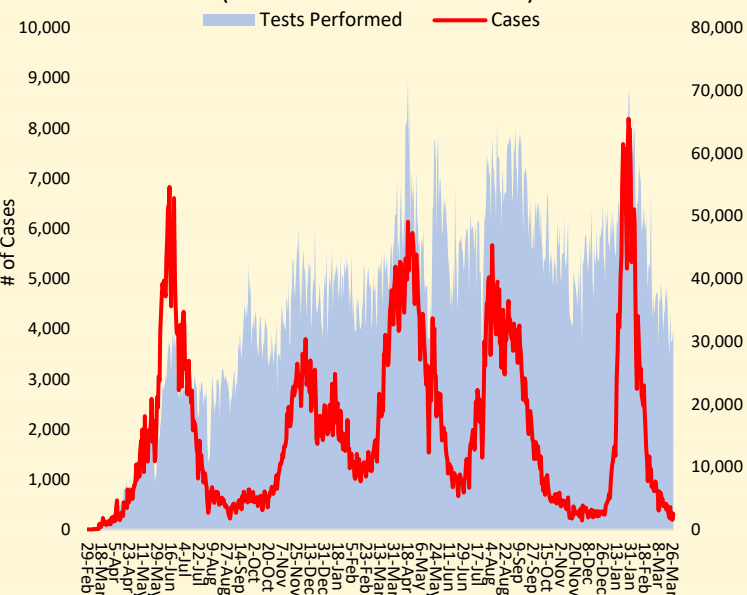

## Meetings & Coordination

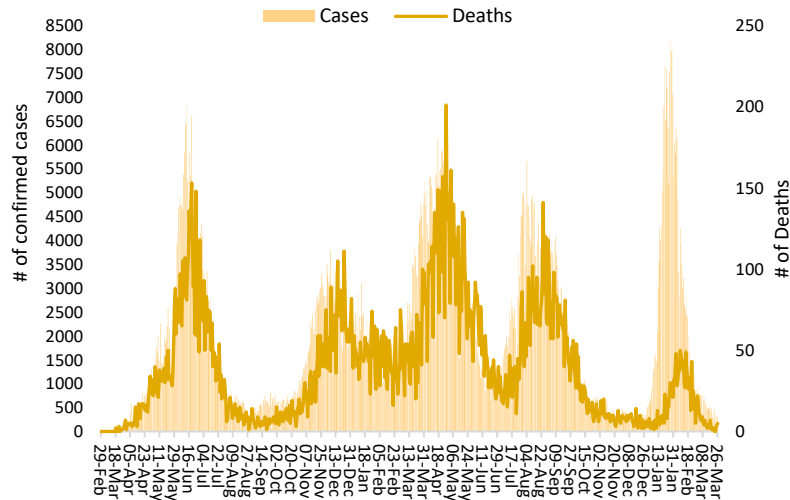


The provincial health department Sindh in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan conducted a two-day training (21st to 22nd March 2022) of trainers on Baby Friendly Hospital initiative and Lactation Management (BFHI) at Indus Hospital Karachi. There were 35 participants from the Indus Hospital, Aga Khan Hospital and Liaquat National Hospital Karachi, including Pediatricians, Obstetricians, Gynecologists and Neonatologist. The National Coordinator Nutrition Dr Khawaja Masood, Head of WHO Sub Office Sindh, Dr Sara Salman and Head of Neonatology and Pediatrics Dr Farhan attended the opening session. The objective of the training was to build capacity of staff responsible for maternity and child health services on the protection and promotion of breastfeeding and lactation management.

Dr Syed Rehan Ali, Senior Neonatologist, Indus Hospital Karachi, appreciated WHO for organizing and supporting the training.
