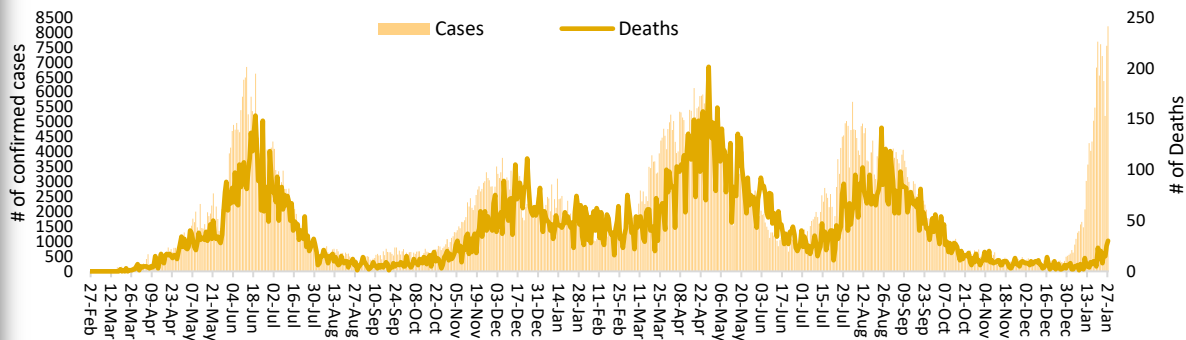

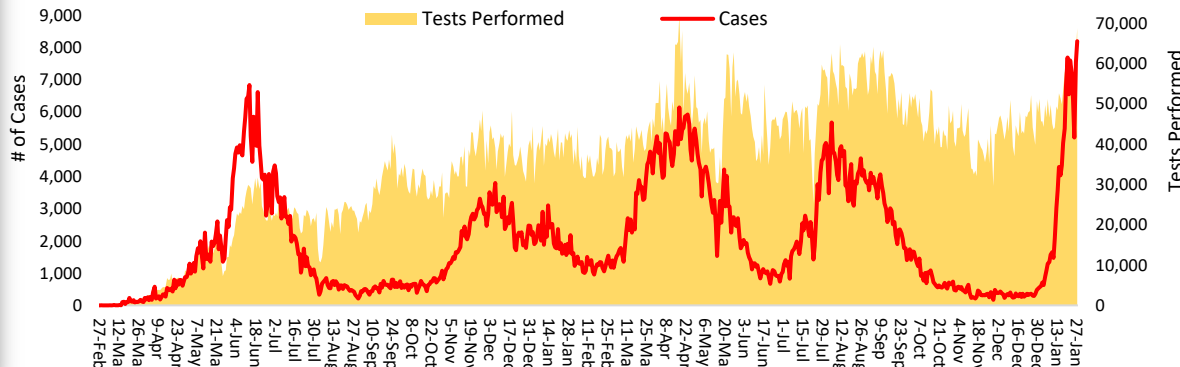

Meeting and Coordination



On 28th January 2022, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr. Palitha Mahipala, along with Mrs. Governor Punjab Madam Parveen Sarwar visited the Sarwar Foundation Hospital Rajana, District Toba Tek Singh with a capacity of 80 beds.

The purpose of the visit was to enhance WHO collaboration with the hospital and establishment of screening facility for girls and women of all ages, including pregnant and lactating mothers through integrated NCD screening for women health. During the visit, enhancement of cervical and breast cancer screening services and upscaling of neonatal ICU were discussed.

Dr. Palitha acknowledged the services being provided at the hospital and assured them of WHO support for establishment of the Well Women Clinic at Rajana Hospital through provision of supplies and technical assistance considered necessary for the functionality of the Well Women Clinic.

Mrs. Governor Madam Parveen Sarwar appreciated the support of WHO and emphasized on the continuity of quality RMNCAH services and immunization services for mothers and children at the hospital.

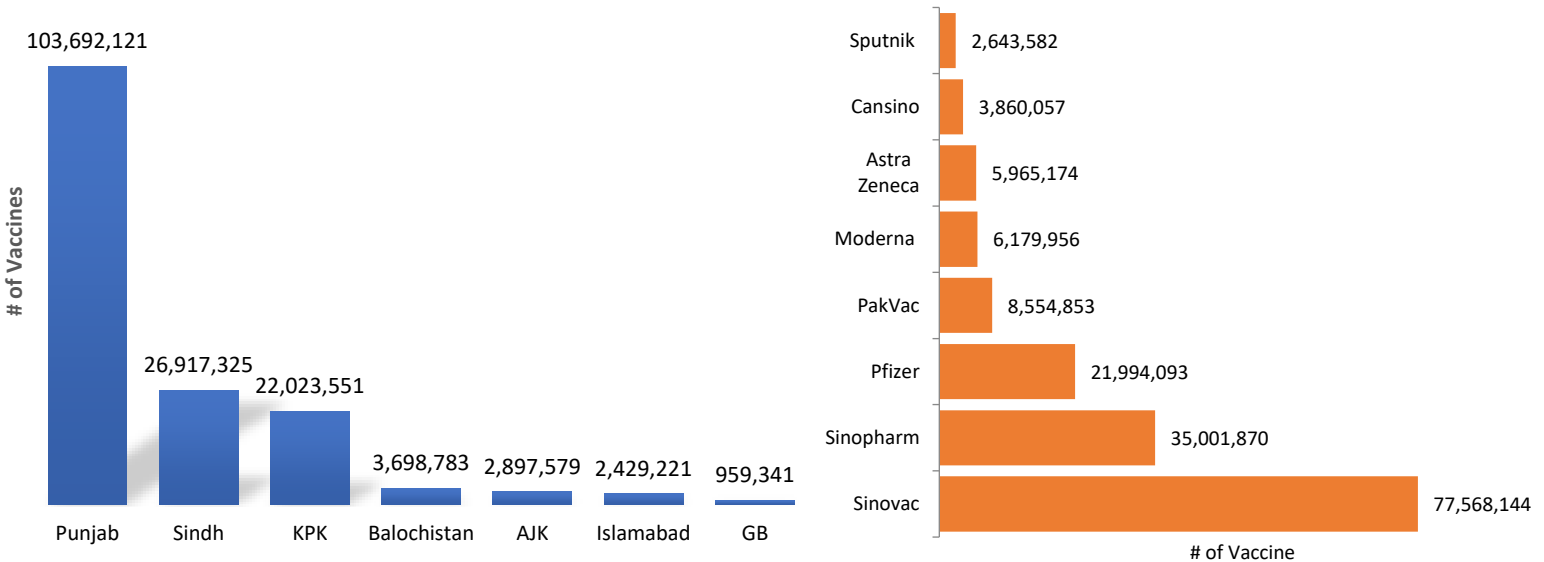

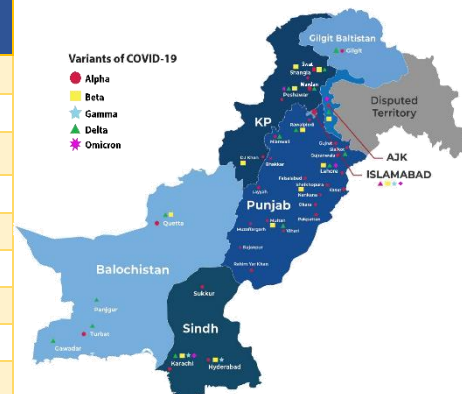
