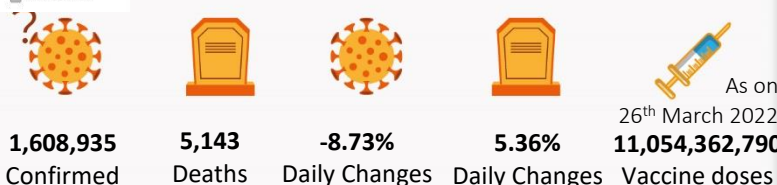

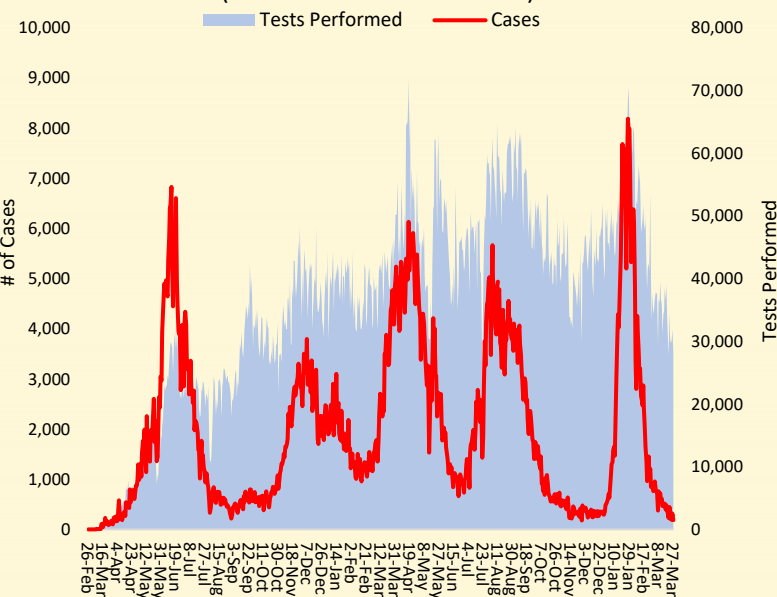

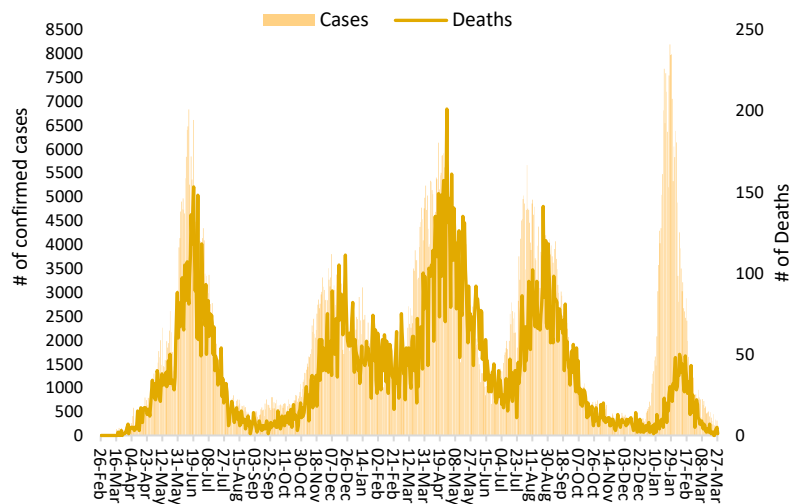

On 25th March 2022, Provincial Health Department, Balochistan in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan organized TB awareness Seminar to commemorate the World Tuberculosis (TB) Day-2022. The event took place at Serena Hotel, Quetta, under the theme “Invest to End TB, Save Lives.” Participants included the Director General Health Services Balochistan, Dr Noor Muhammad, Provincial manager TB Control Programme Dr Asif Shah-wani and Head of WHO Sub Office Balochistan Dr Asfandyar Sherani. Dr Sherani informed participants that, the World TB Day is commemorated on March 24 every year to raise public awareness on the socio-economic and health consequences of TB infection as well as to highlight efforts to end the global TB epidemic. In his remarks, Dr Noor praised WHO Pakistan for organizing the World TB Day seminar and acknowledged the WHO support.
