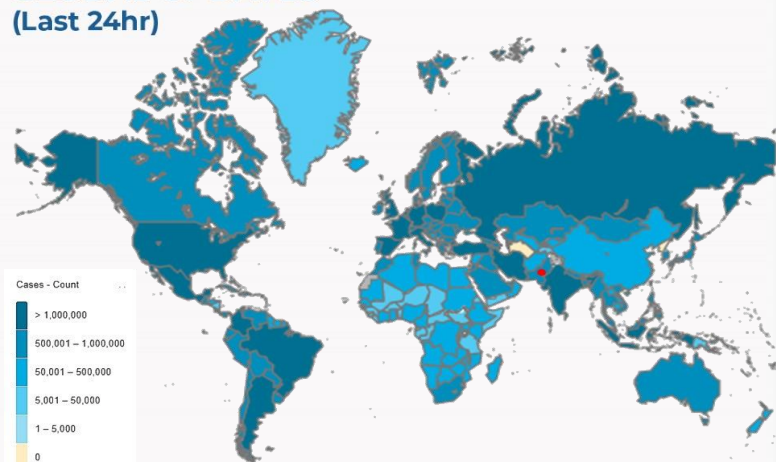

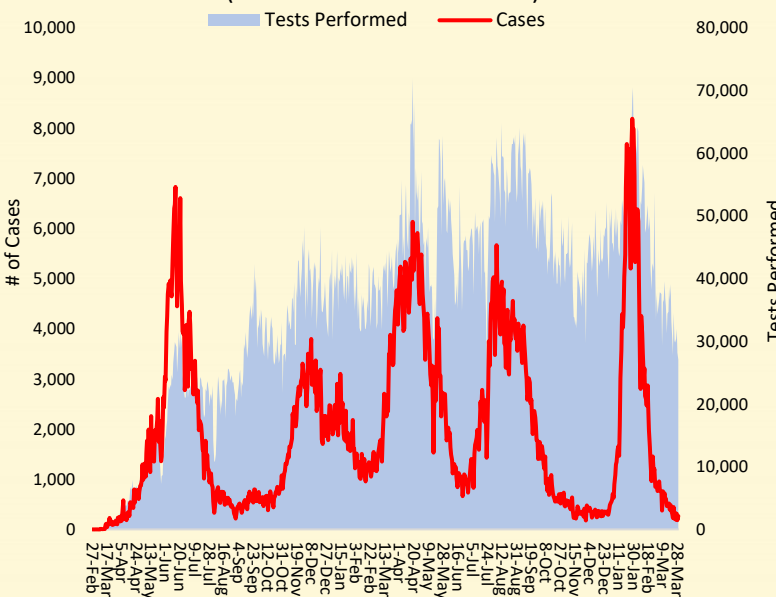

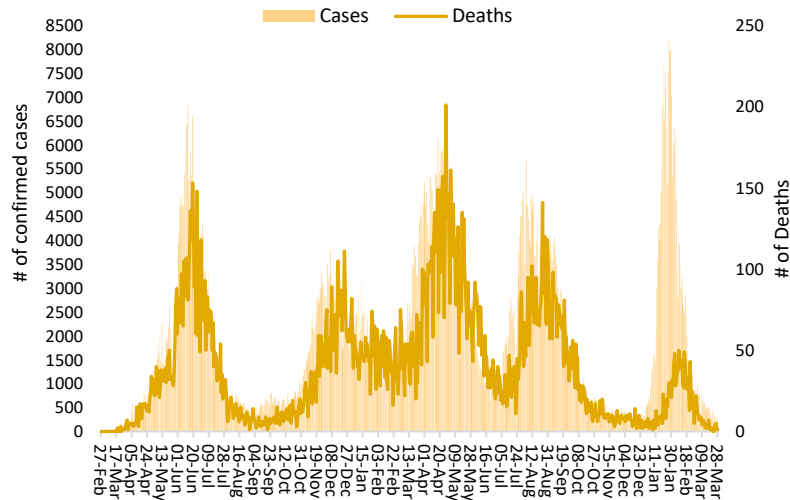


On 29th March 2022, The WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala along with Parliamentary Secretary Health Dr Nausheen Hamid jointly chaired the inaugural session of Multisectoral Coordination Meeting to Strengthen Civil Registration Vital Statistic (CRVS) in Pakistan. The session took place at Serena Hotel Islamabad and was attended by Deputy Director of Programs MNHSR&C Dr Sabeen Afzal, National Technical Advisor Ministry of Planning Dr Syed M Mursaleen, among others.

In his address Dr Palitha highlighted on the importance of vital events registration and WHO support to CRVS in Pakistan. He stated that “better collaboration and more investments from stakeholders will accelerate the progress”. Dr Nausheen Hamid apprised the participants on various initiatives taken by health sector to strengthen Health Information System particularly the registration of deaths, births and causes of deaths. He stated that these statistics are critical in understanding the SDGs and meeting the triple billion targets.
