



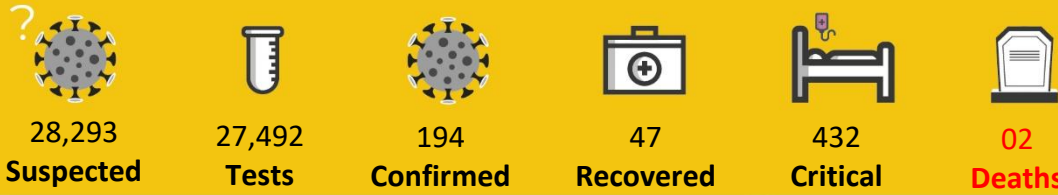

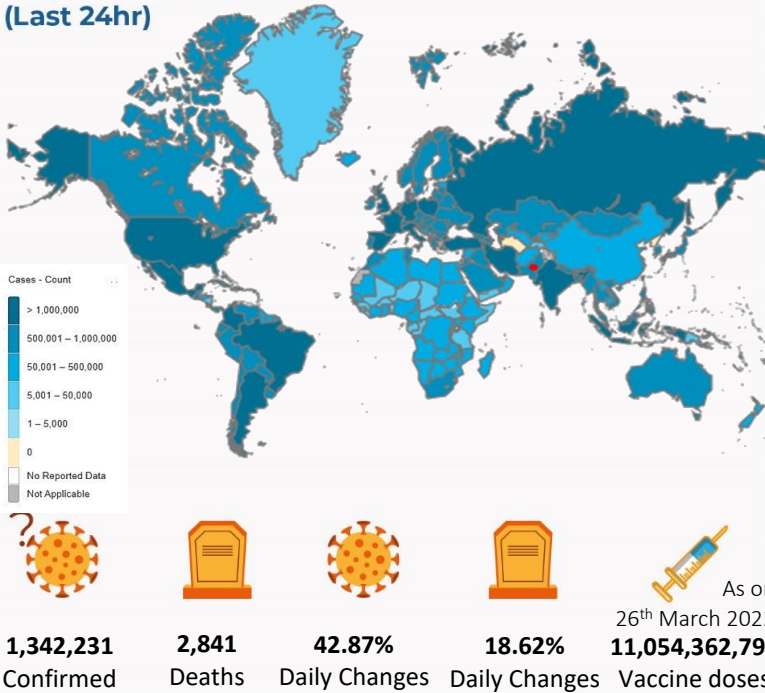

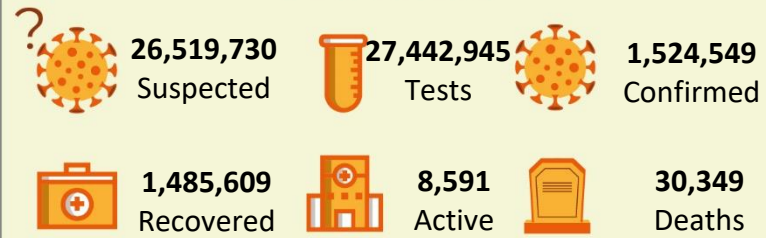
PAKISTAN SNAPSHOT (LAST 24hr)

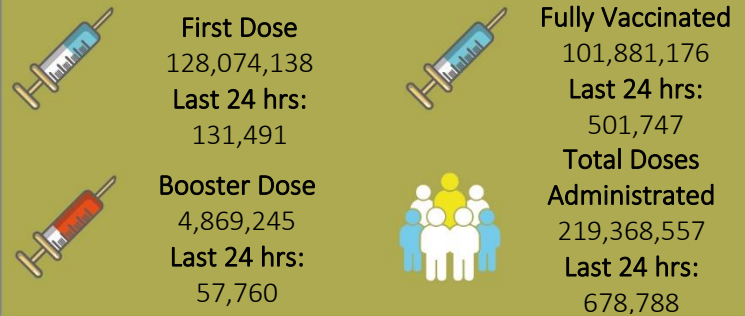


PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

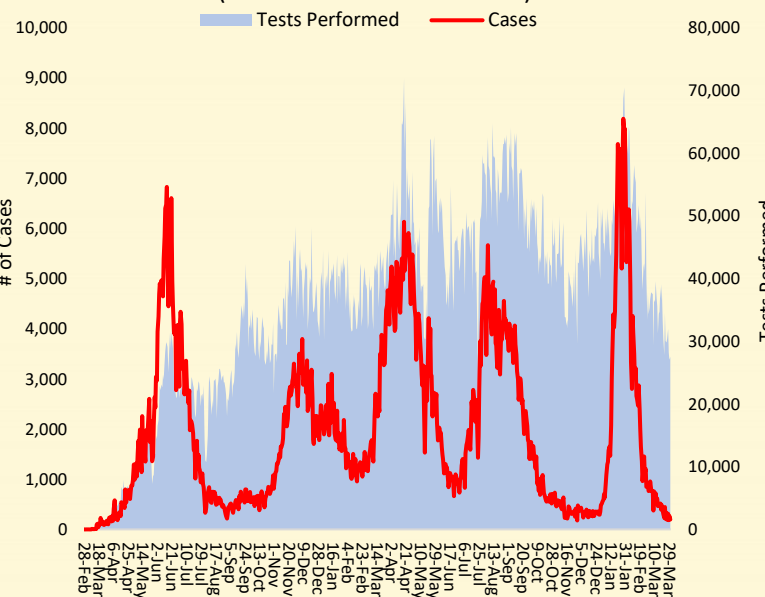

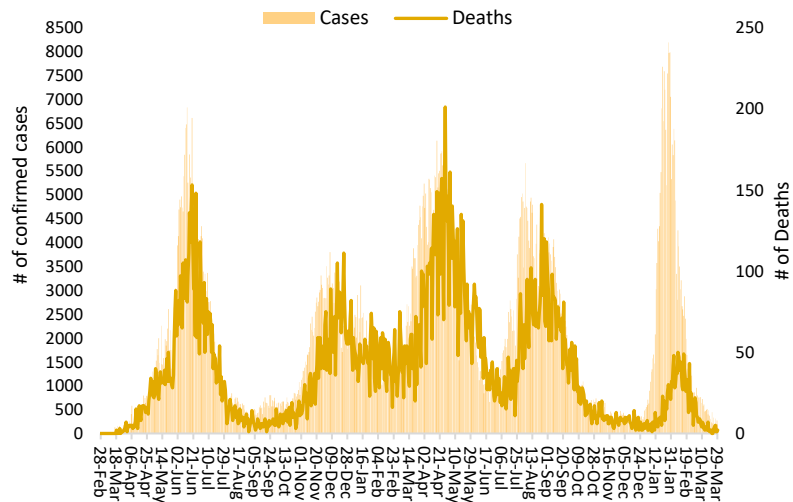


On 29th March 2022, National TB Program, common management unit for HIV, TB, and Malaria in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan commemorated World TB Day 2022 at Pakistan National Council of the Arts, Islamabad. The occasion was graced by WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala and Special Assistant to Prime Minister on Health Dr Faisal Sultan. The function was attended by among others; the Parliamentary secretary MoNHSR&C Dr Nausheen Hamid, National Coordinator Common Management Unit for HIV, TB & Malaria Mr Muhammad Bashir Khetran, National Coordinator (TB) Dr Abdul Wali Khan and Country Director for UNAIDS Ms. Yuki Takemoto.

In his address, Dr Palitha, emphasized on the need to strengthen TB case identification and pledged WHO commitment to ensure TB free Pakistan. Dr Faisal noted with appreciation the improvement in TB case notification during 2021.
