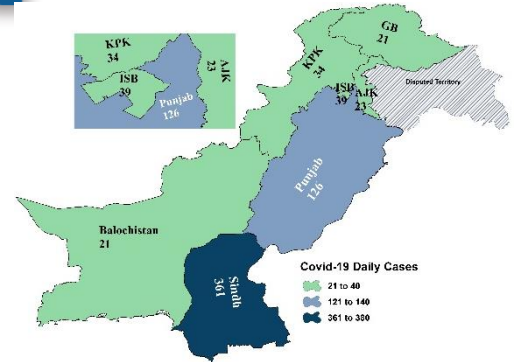

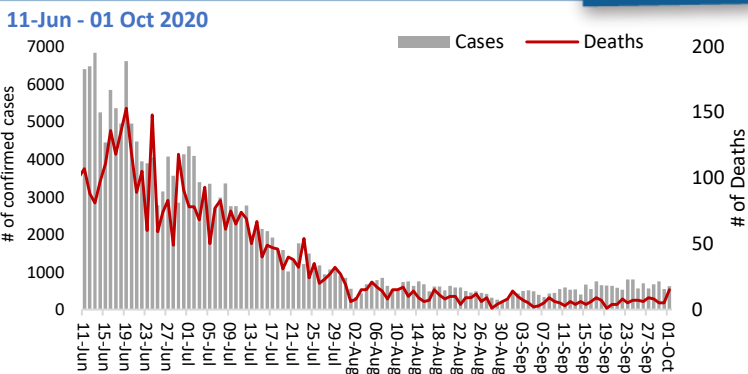
Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **625** new cases of COVID-19 on **01 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **313,431** with **6,499** deaths (**CFR: 2.07%**). Out of the total **8,877** currently active cases, **720** cases are hospitalized, out of which **480** (**66.66%**) are in critical condition. **8,157** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **298,055** (**95.09%**) have recovered and discharged.

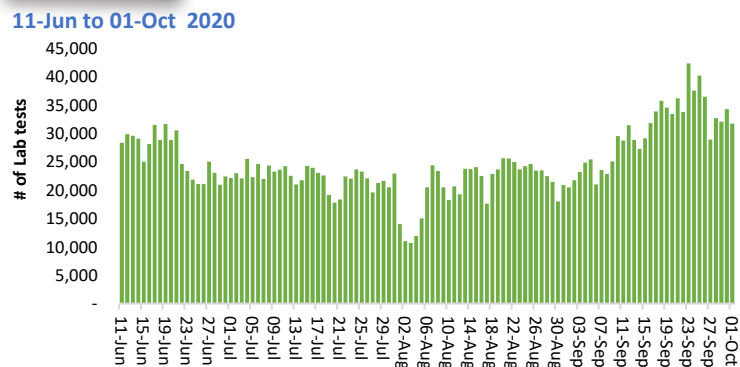
Daily Incidence by Province



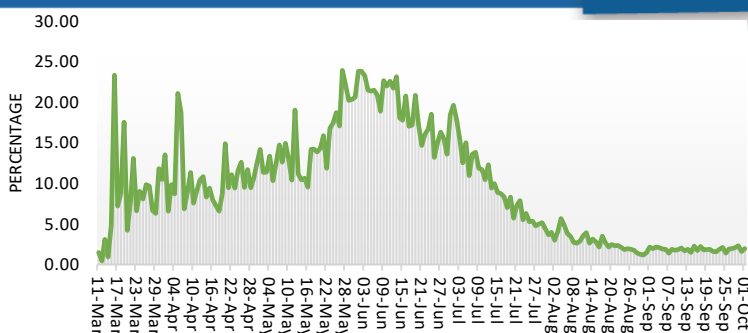
Daily Incidence/Mortality



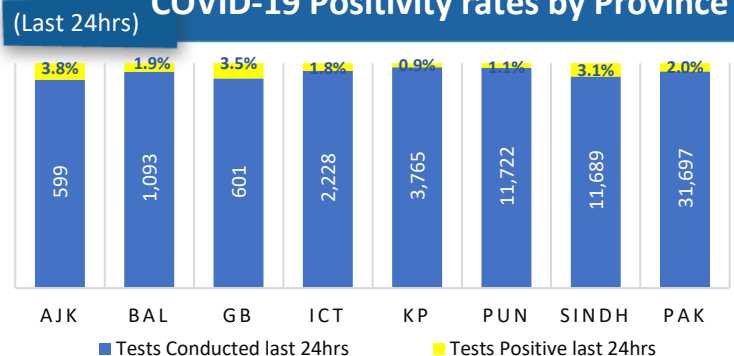
Daily Lab Test conducted

Meetings & Coordination

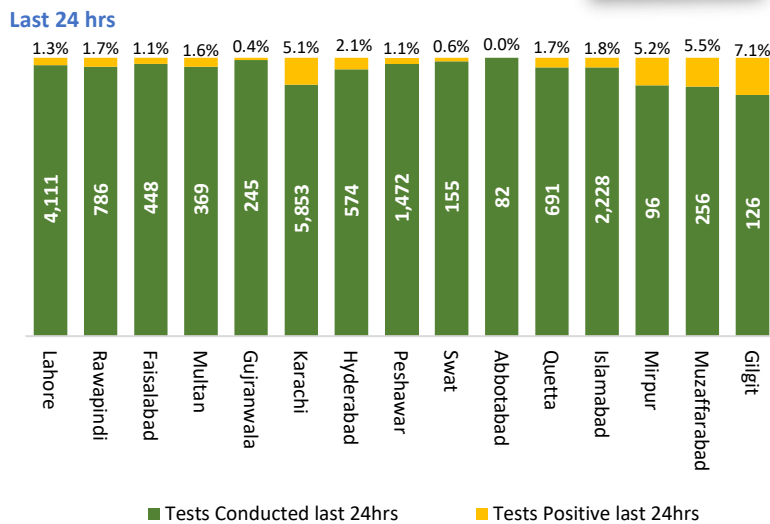
