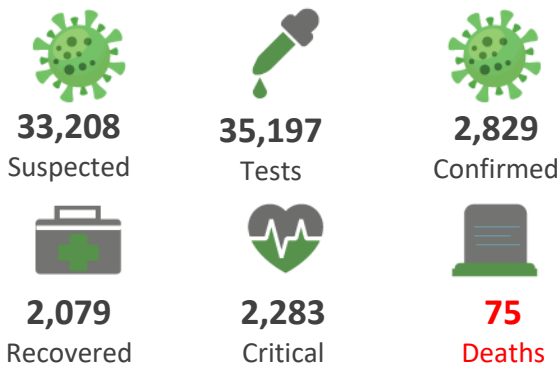


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



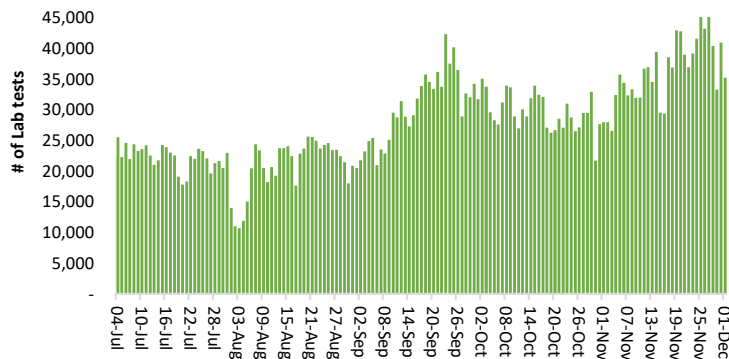
Pakistan reported **2,829** new cases of COVID-19 on **01 December 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **403,311** with **8,166** deaths (**CFR: 2.02%**). Out of the total **49,780** currently active cases, **2,810** cases are hospitalized.

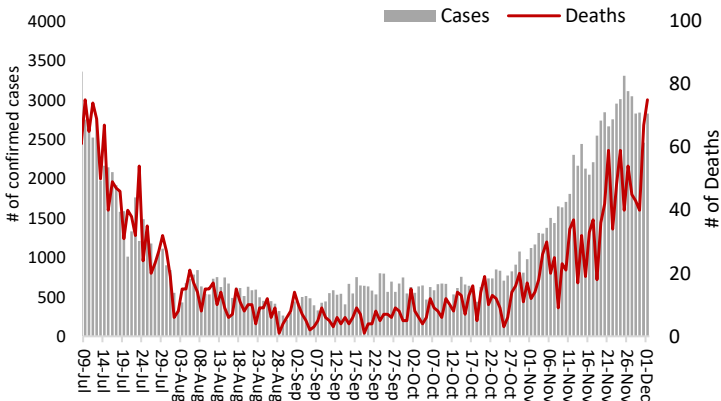

04-Jul to 01-Dec 2020

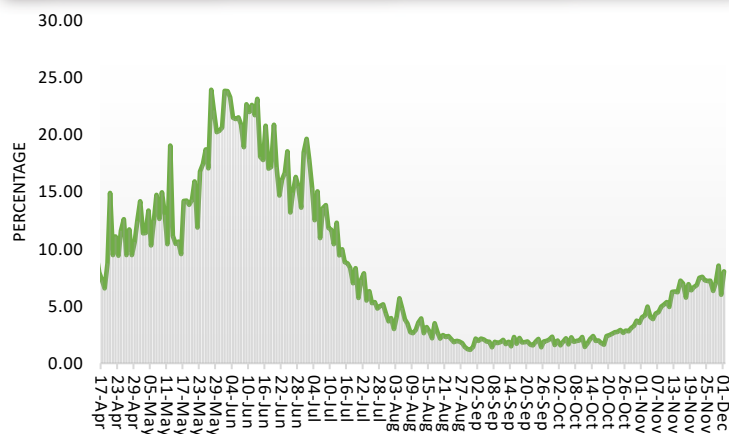


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

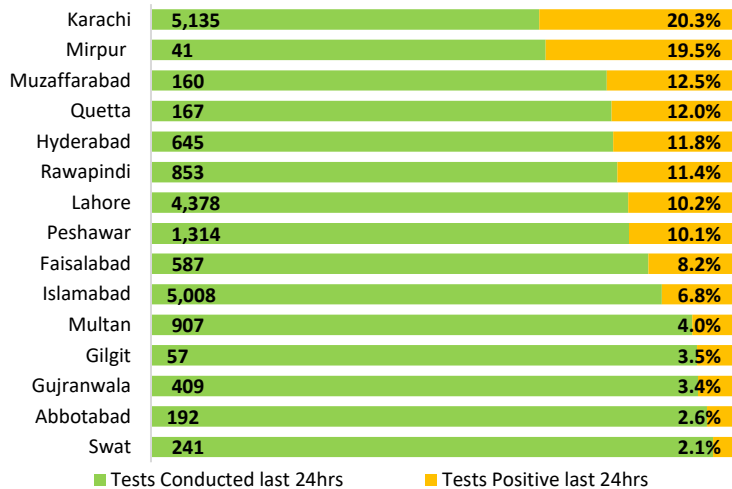
