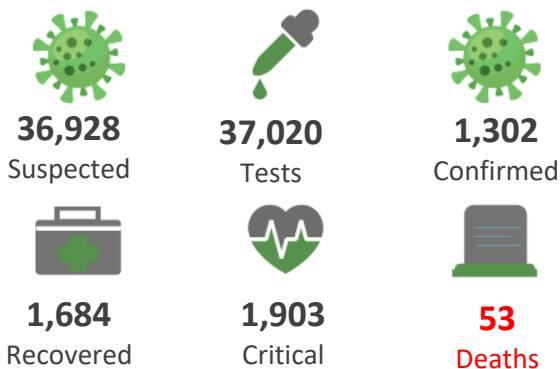


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



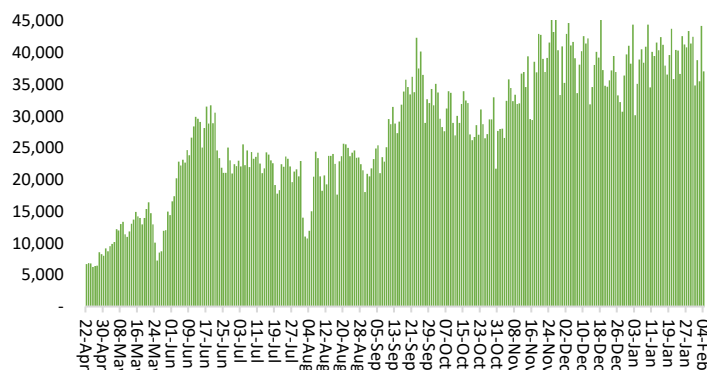
Pakistan reported **1,302** new cases of COVID-19 on **4th February 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **551,842** with **11,886** deaths (**CFR: 2.15%**). Out of the total **32,454** currently active cases **2,345** cases are hospitalized.

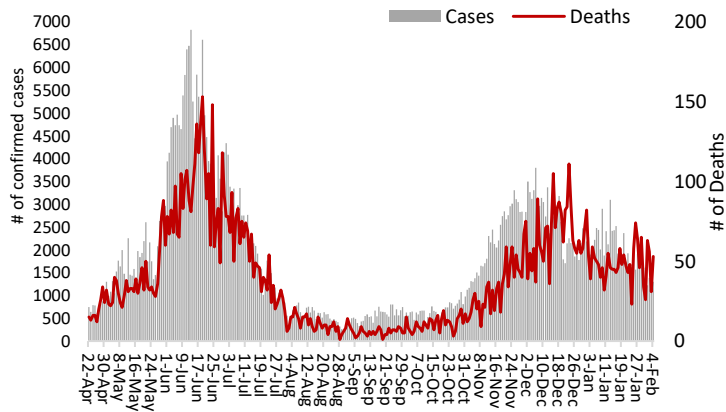
LAB TEST (PCR + RA) CONDUCTED BY DATE

22-April 2020 - 04-Feb 2021

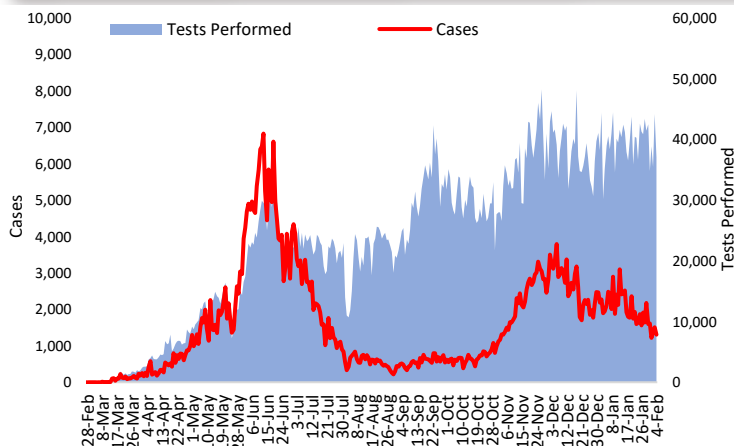


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

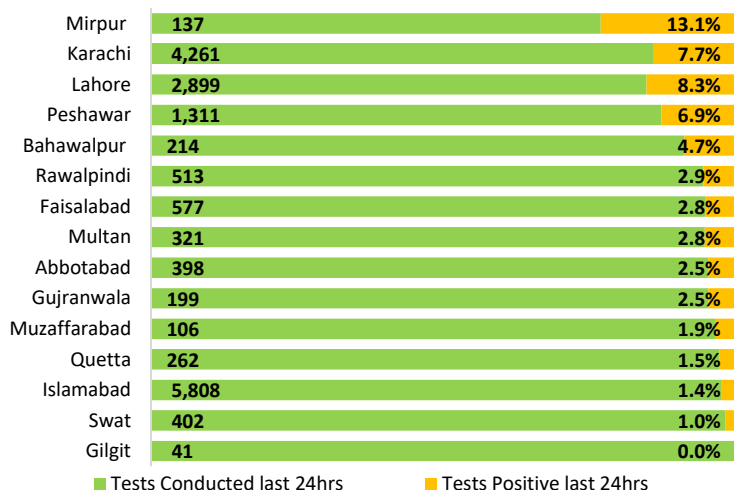
On 5th February 2021, World Health Organization Pakistan conducted a virtual meeting with the United Nations High Commission for Refugees (UNCHR) Country Representative in Pakistan. The Objective of the meeting was to discuss ensuring inclusion of refugees in the COVID-19 vaccination campaign. EPI Team lead, Dr Osama Mere, and NPO, IHR Dr Farah Sabih, from WHO attended the meeting.

Dr Osama briefed the meeting on the ongoing national vaccine and deployment plan, the prioritization process for the target group for the first wave of the vaccination campaign, future plan of the government of Pakistan to vaccinate more people and WHO support to the Government of Pakistan to implement the national vaccine and deployment plan for COVID-19 vaccination.

The meeting concluded that there is need for more collaborations between WHO and UNHCR especially during the implementation of the vaccination campaign.
