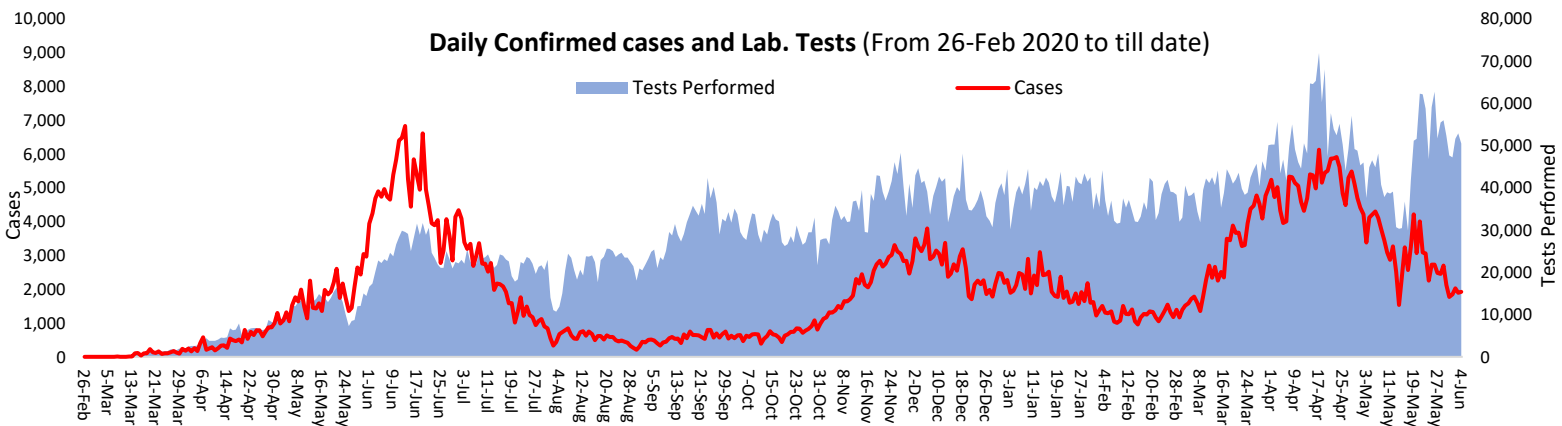
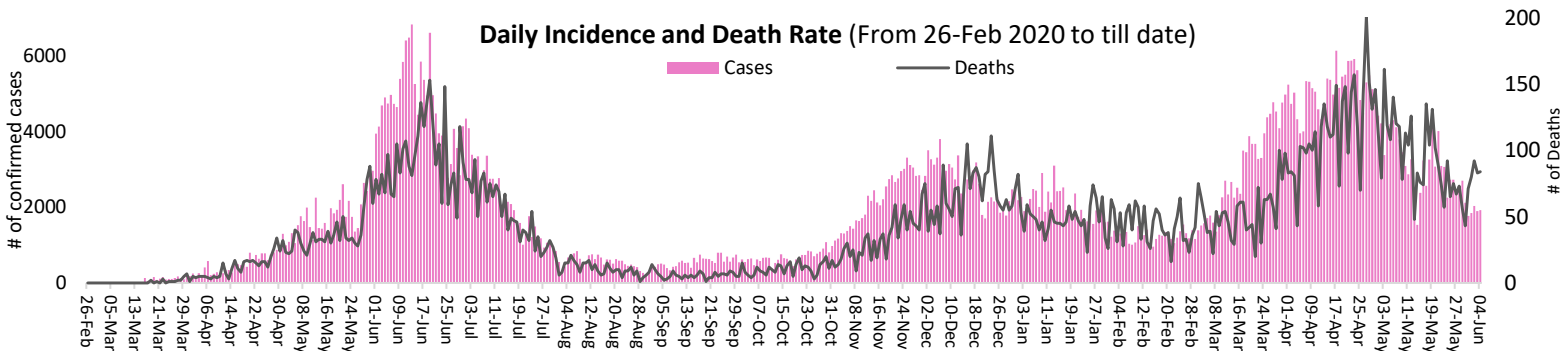

Meeting and Coordination



On 4th June 2021, World Health Organization Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala officiated at a Tobacco awareness campaign in Islamabad. The ceremony was organized by Tobacco Control Cell of the Ministry of National Health Services Regulation & Coordination and Islamabad Traffic Police (ITP) and in attendance were: The Head of Tobacco Control Cell and Deputy Director Programs, Dr. Samra Mazhar, traffic police officials, volunteers from PRC, representatives of Islamabad Smoke-free project and WHO NPO on Tobacco Control, Mr Shahzad Alam khan.

The campaign was held under the theme, "Quitters are Winners" and meant to promote tobacco-free environments, at home, workplace, and public and private transport vehicles. During the ceremony, participants carried placards and flyers inscribed with anti-tobacco messages. Dr Palitha reminded the participants that tobacco kills and encouraged smokers to quit.
