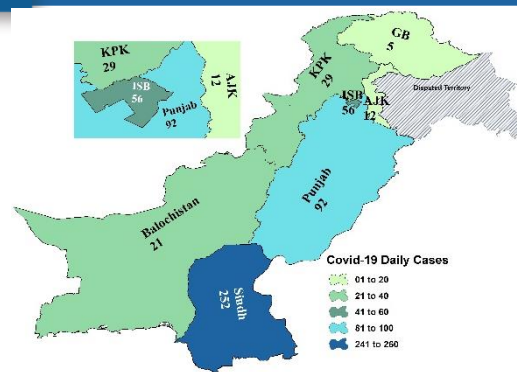

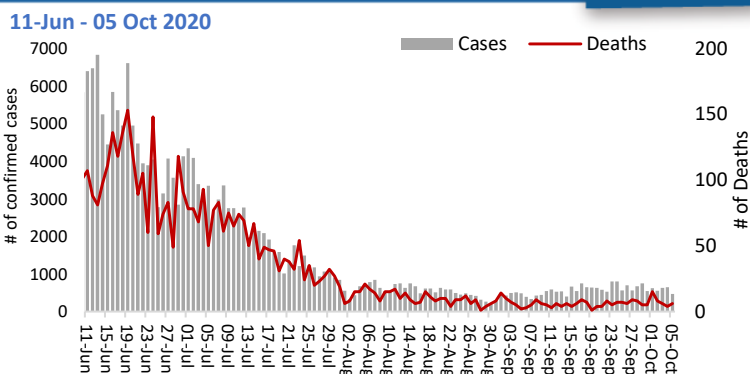
Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **467** new cases of COVID-19 on **05 October 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **315,727** with **6,523** deaths (**CFR: 2.07%**). Out of the total **8,588** currently active cases, **793** cases are hospitalized, out of which **516 (65.07%)** are in critical condition. **7,795** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **300,616 (95.21%)** have recovered and discharged.

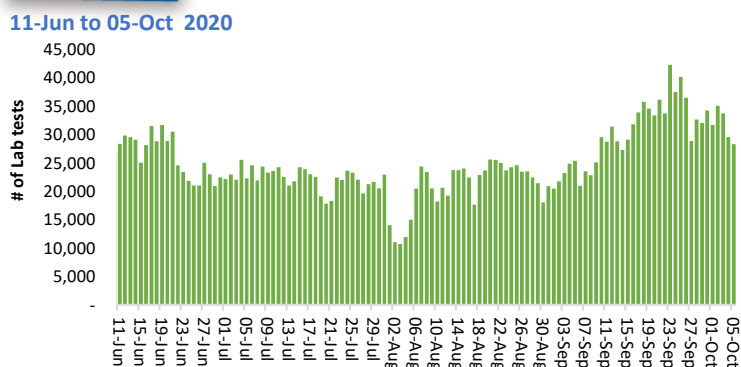
Daily Incidence by Province



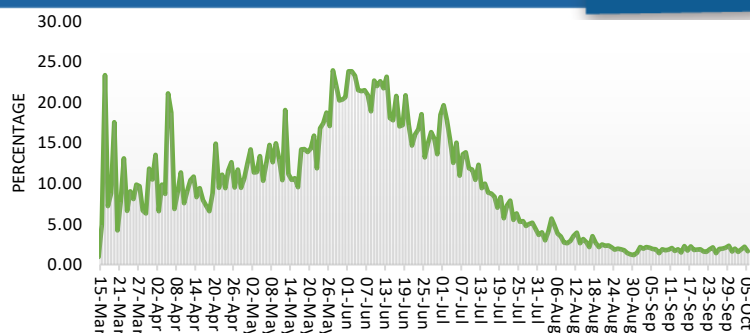
Daily Incidence/Mortality



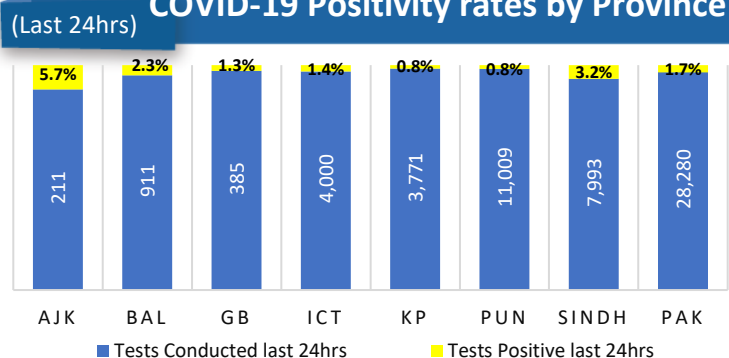
Daily Lab Test conducted

COVID-19 Positivity rates by Province

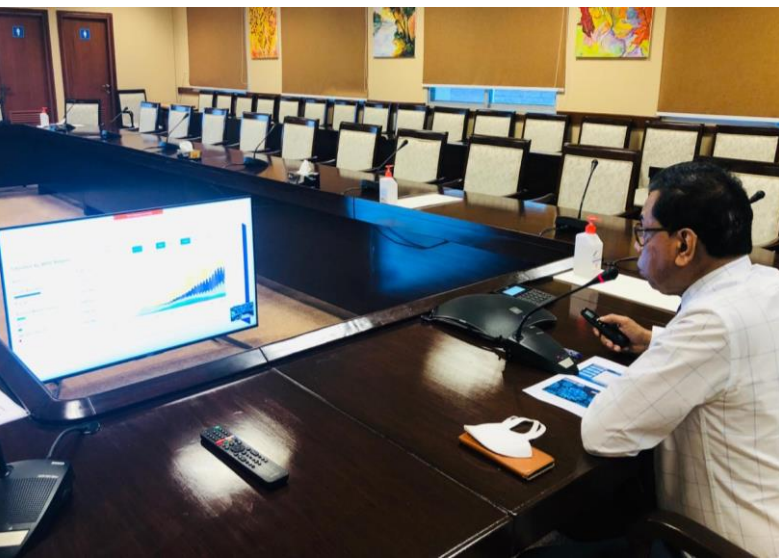

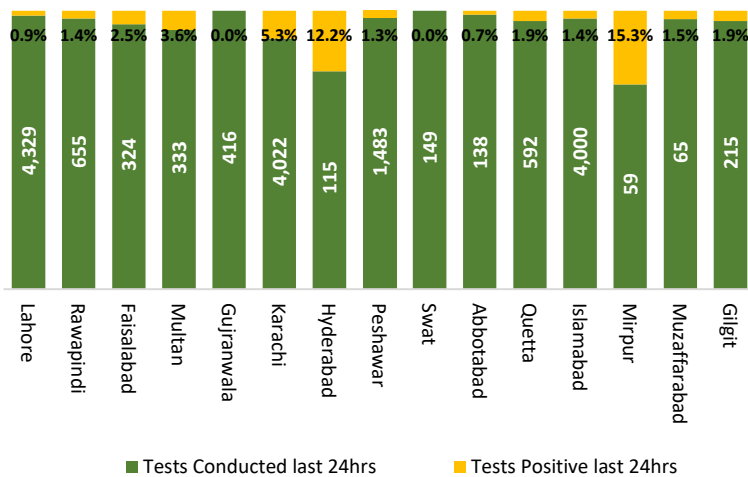
