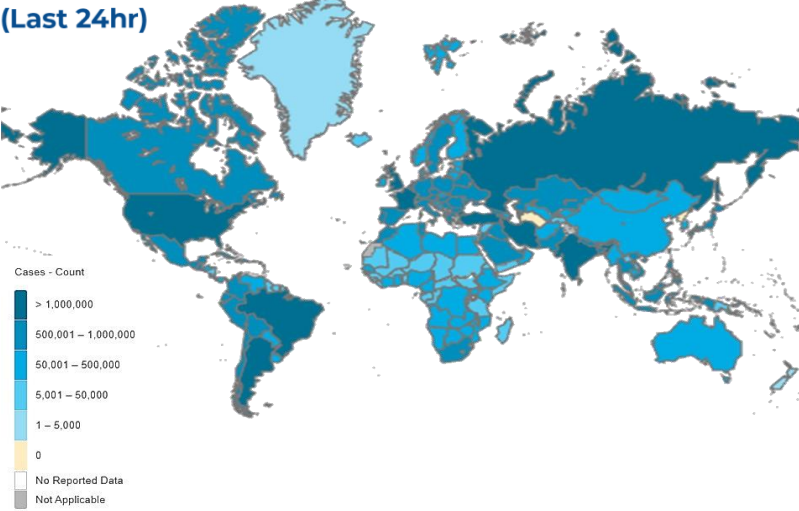
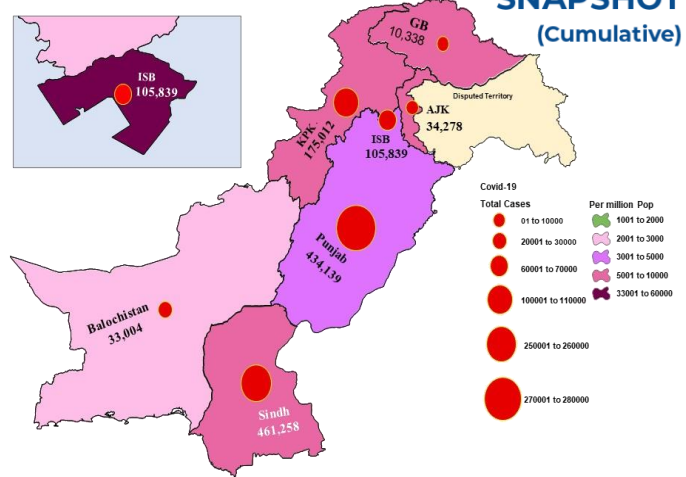

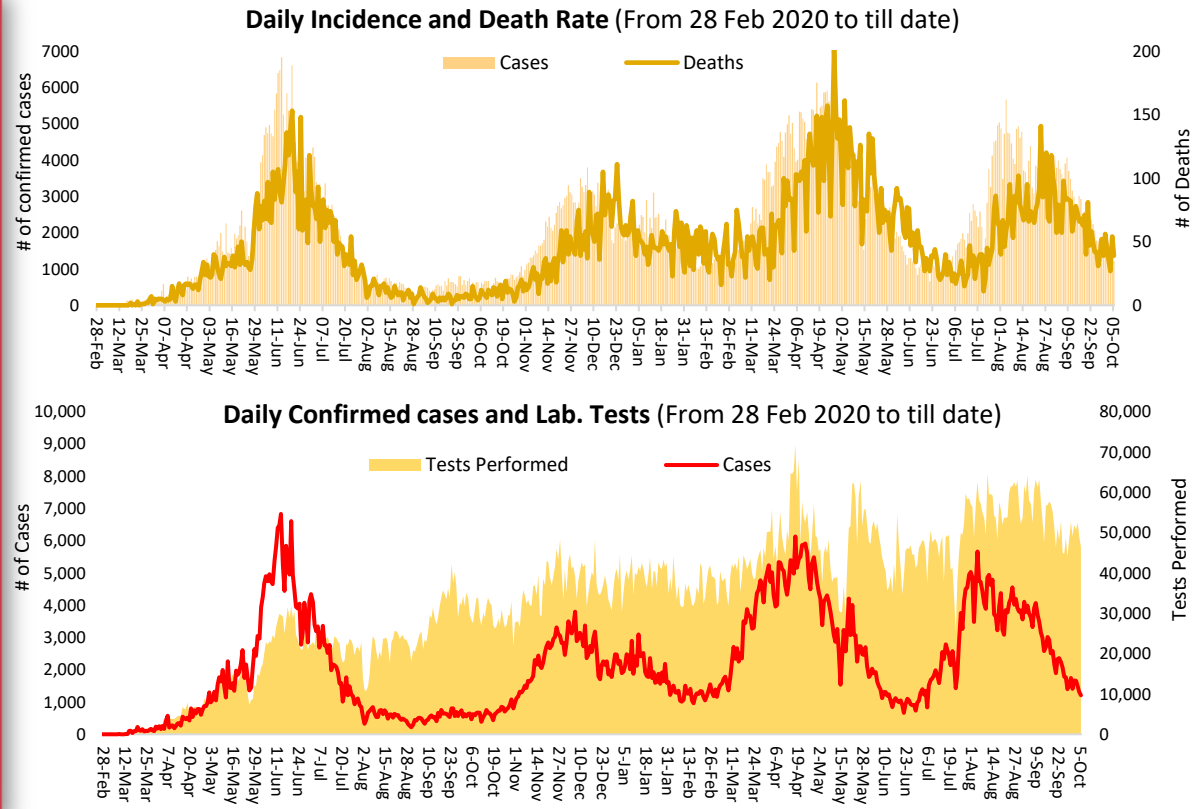

The Ministry of National Health Services Regulation & Coordination in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan organized a capacity building workshop for Family Physicians on Antimicrobial Resistance (AMR) from 5th to 6th October 2021 at Health Services Academy (HSA), Islamabad. The workshop was facilitated by trainers from HSA. The opening ceremony was graced by WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala and the Vice Chancellor HSA, Dr Shahzad Ali Khan. In his speech, Dr Palitha highlighted on the dangers of irrational prescription of antimicrobial drugs. He encouraged the family physicians serving at community and primary health care level to reverse this trend. The Vice Chancellor Health Services Academy Dr. Shahzad Ali Khan thanked the WHO for supporting the training and reiterated on the commitment of HSA to build capacity of health workers.
