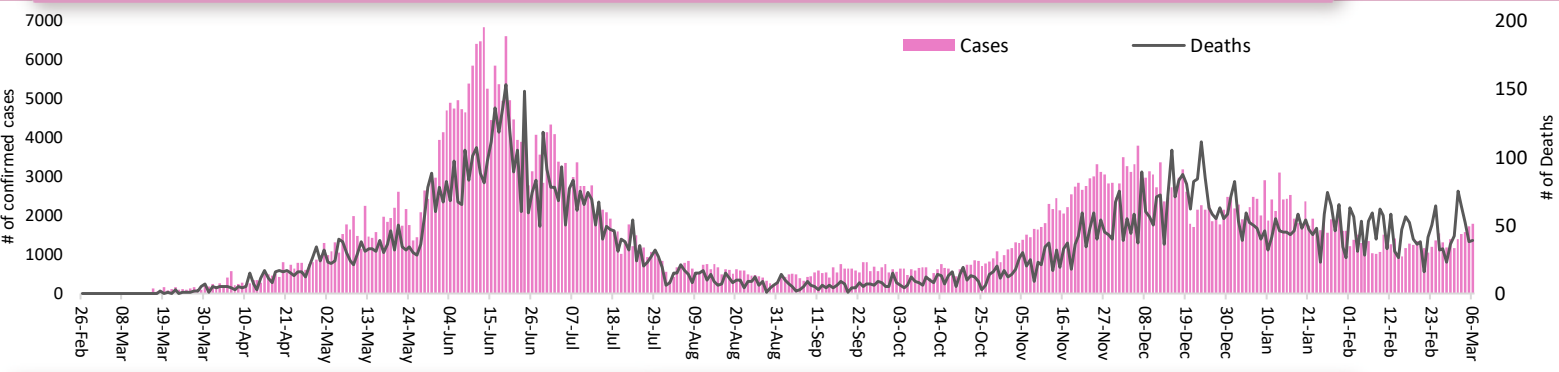

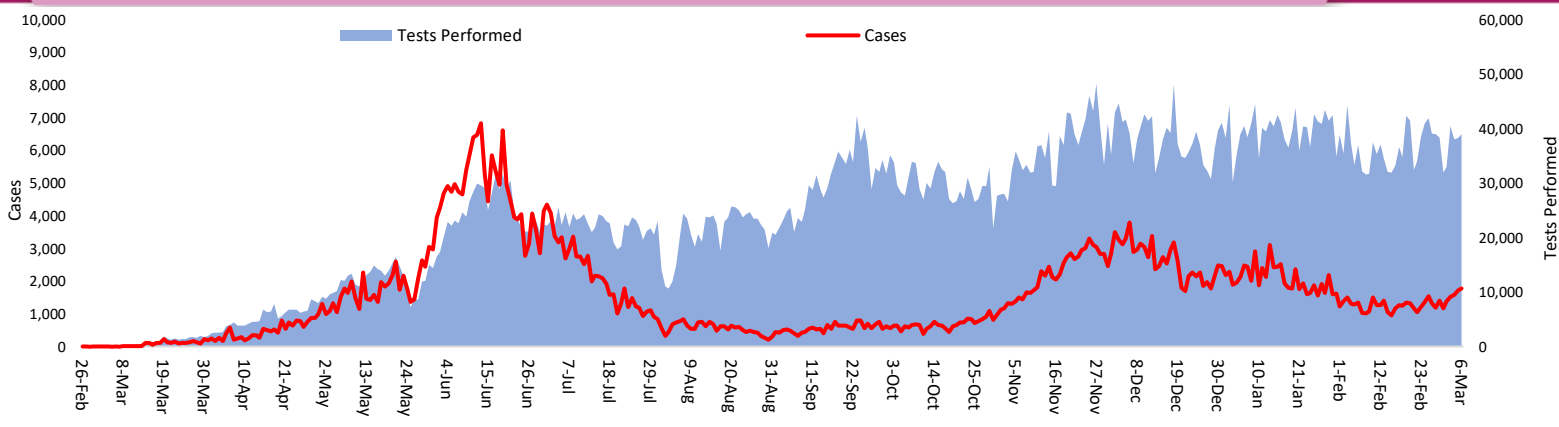

## MEETING AND COORDINATION

On 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2021, WHO technical Officer (labs) Dr Uzma Bashir along with senior Laboratory Technologist from National Institute of Health (NIH) and Dr Zakir Ali district Lab Focal person conducted a monitoring visit of the COVID-19 testing Laboratory at Civil Hospital Bahawalpur. The Medical Superintendent (MS) Civil Hospital, Dr Muhammad Yousaf Rana and senior laboratory technologist Mr Imran Sarwar received the mission team. The team visited and reviewed the arrangements in different sections of the laboratory including sample reception, PCR testing, result reporting and waste disposal and discussed the key observations with the lab teams. The laboratory has performed over 140,000 PCR tests for SARS-CoV2 till date, covering Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Lodhran, Vehari and Rahim Yar Khan districts. WHO Pakistan has supported this facility with QS5 real time PCR equipment and staff trainings on Diagnostics, Lab quality management system and Bio-risk management. Dr Zakir and the Civil Hospital team appreciated the continuing WHO support for COVID19 testing and response.
