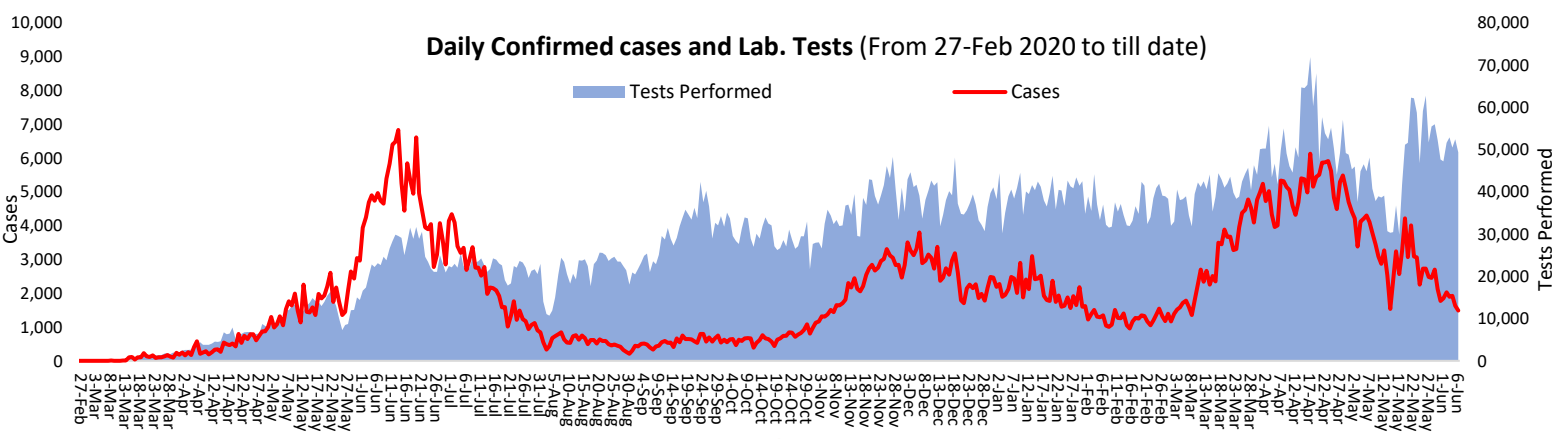

Meeting and Coordination



On 6th June 2021, WHO Regional Director for the Eastern Mediterranean Region, Dr Ahmed Al-Mandhari and WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala commissioned the nutrition stabilization center in Pakistan Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS) Hospital, Islamabad. The ceremony was attended by Director/National Program Manager, Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations and Coordination, Dr. Abdul Baseer Khan Achakzai, and senior pediatricians at the hospital.

The Regional Director appreciated the high quality of service being provided at the nutrition stabilization centre and requested for the maintenance of the service quality. WHO Pakistan has been supporting management of severe acutely malnourished children at the hospital and in his speech the WR reechoed this support and pledged WHO Pakistan commitment to continue supporting management of pediatric malnutrition.
