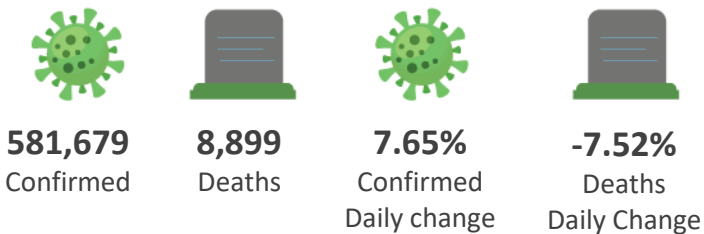


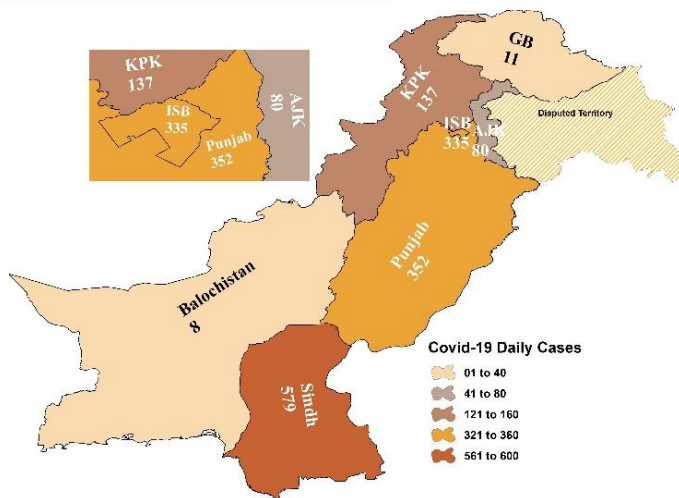

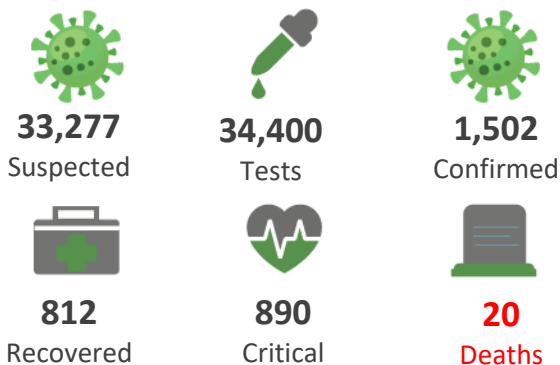


DAILY INCIDENCE BY PROVINCE



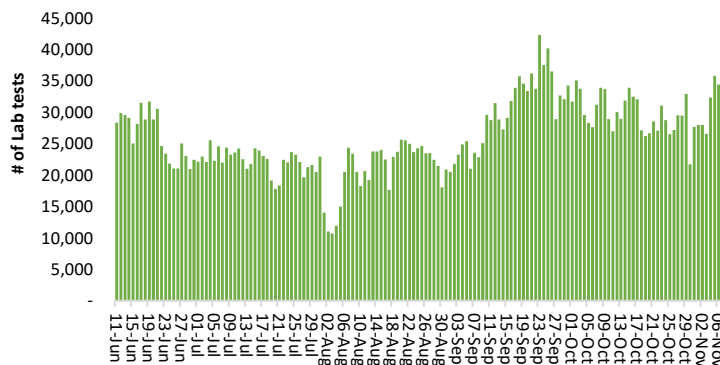
Pakistan reported **1,502** new cases of COVID-19 on **06 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **341,753** with **6,943** deaths (**CFR: 2.03%**). Out of the total **16,912** currently active cases, **1,057** cases are hospitalized.

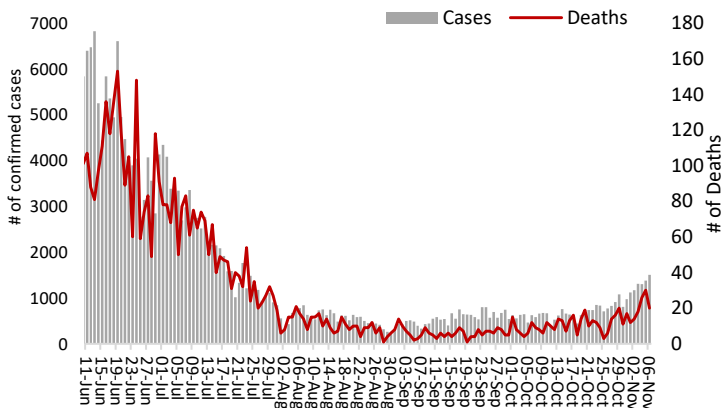
LAB TEST CONDUCTED BY DATE

11-Jun to 06-Nov 2020

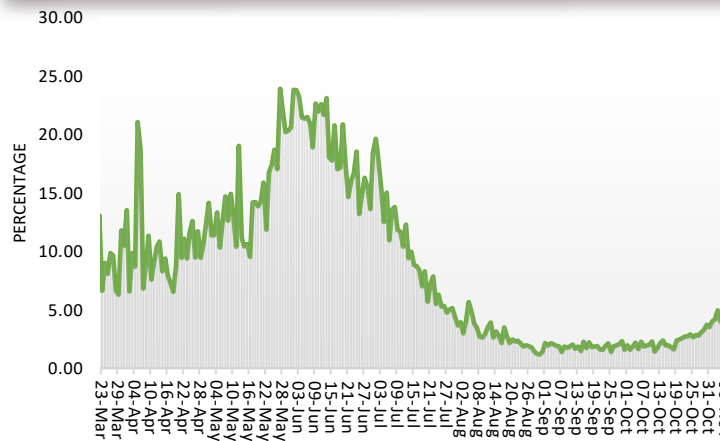


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

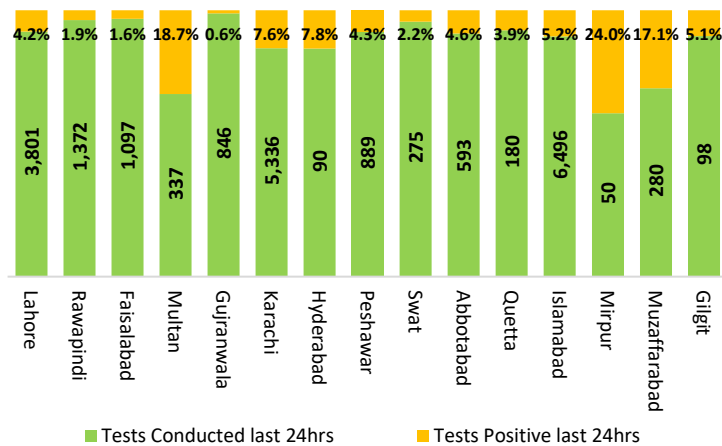
