

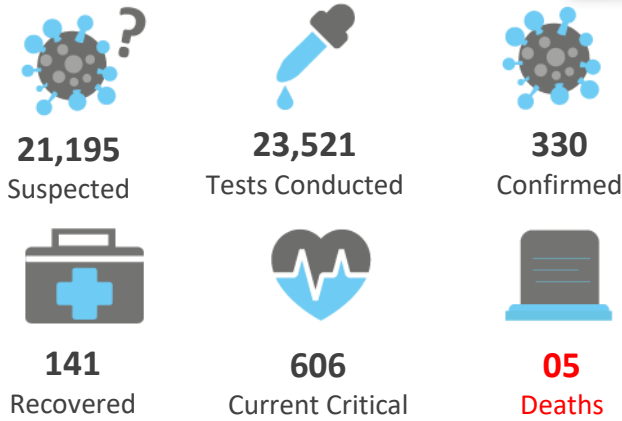

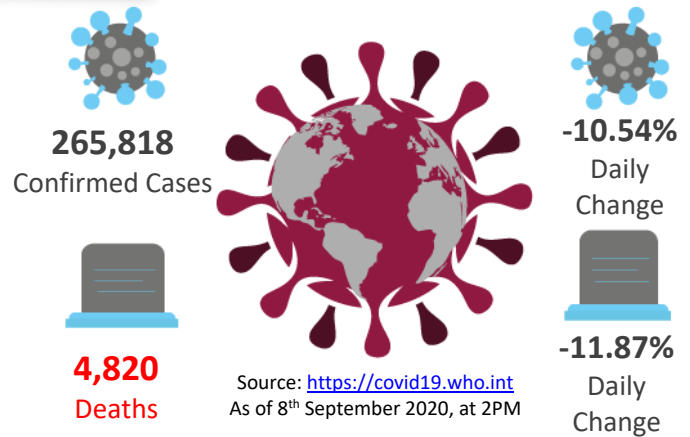

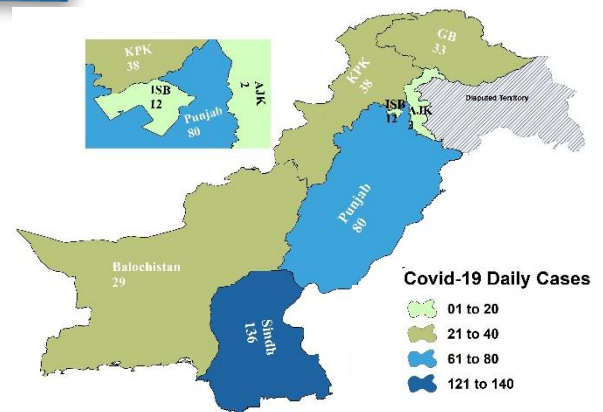

Executive Summary

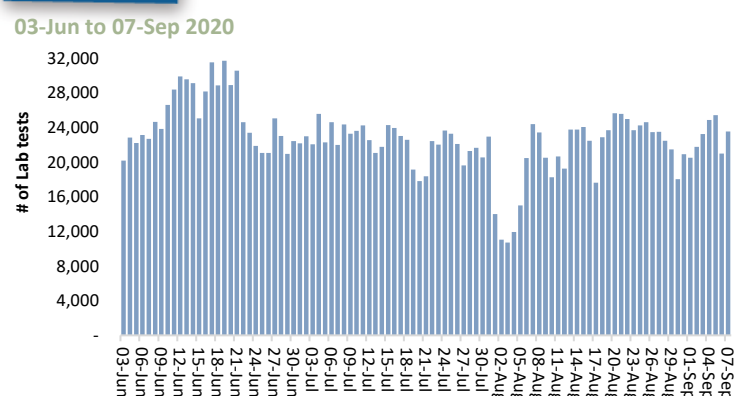
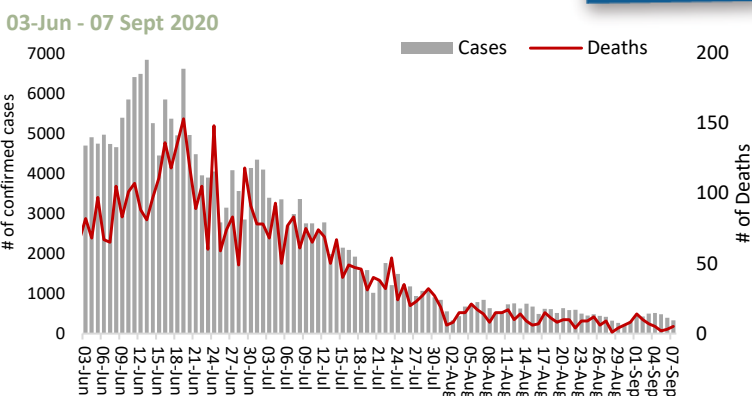
Daily Incidence by Province

Pakistan reported **330** new cases of COVID-19 on **7 September 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **299,233** with **6,350** deaths (**CFR: 2.12%**). Out of the total **6,726** currently active cases, **1,047** cases are hospitalized, out of which **606 (57.87%)** are in critical condition. **5,679** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **286,157 (95.63%)** have recovered and discharged.

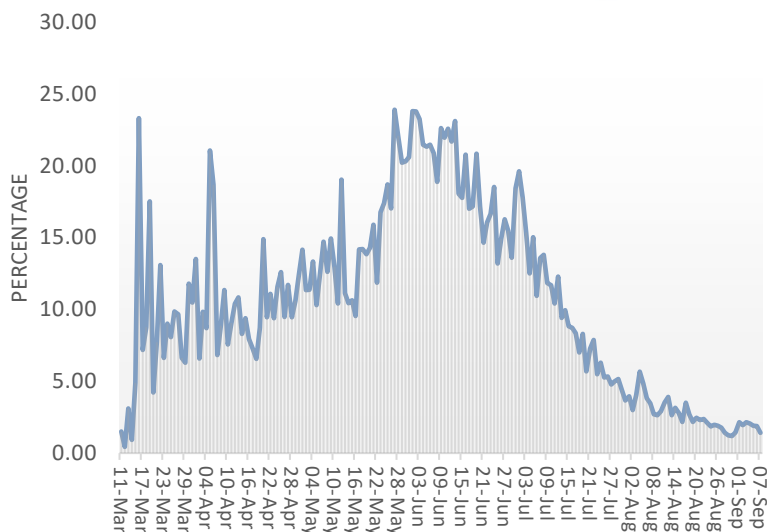

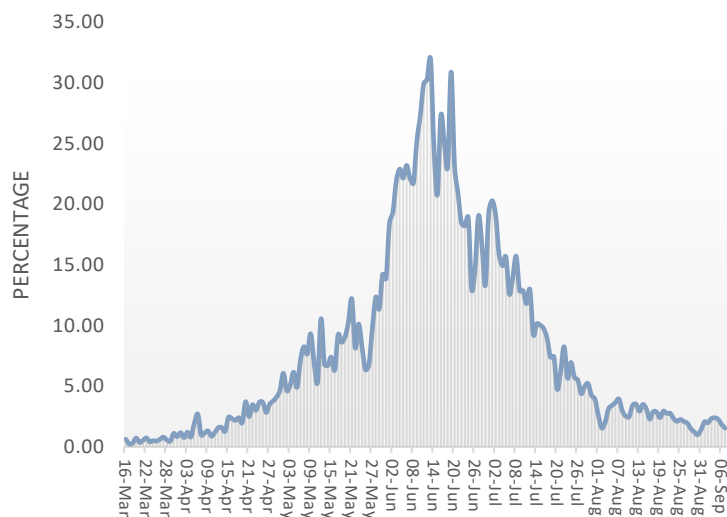

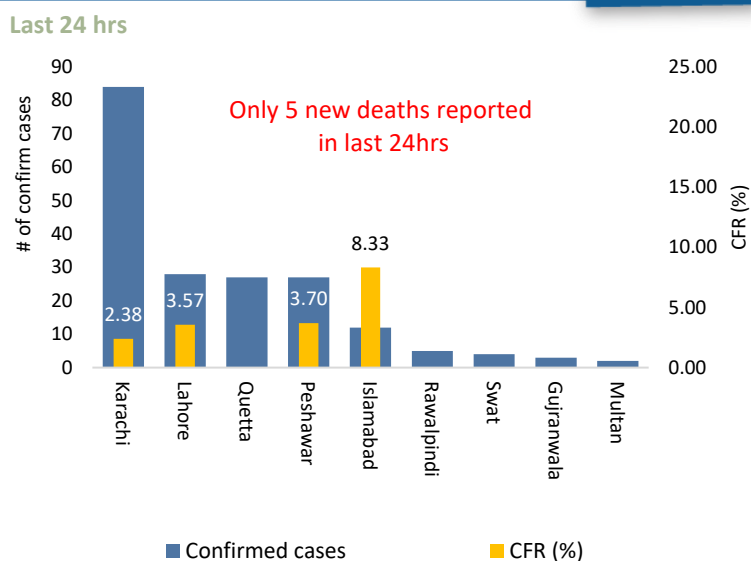
Daily COVID-19 Positivity Rate



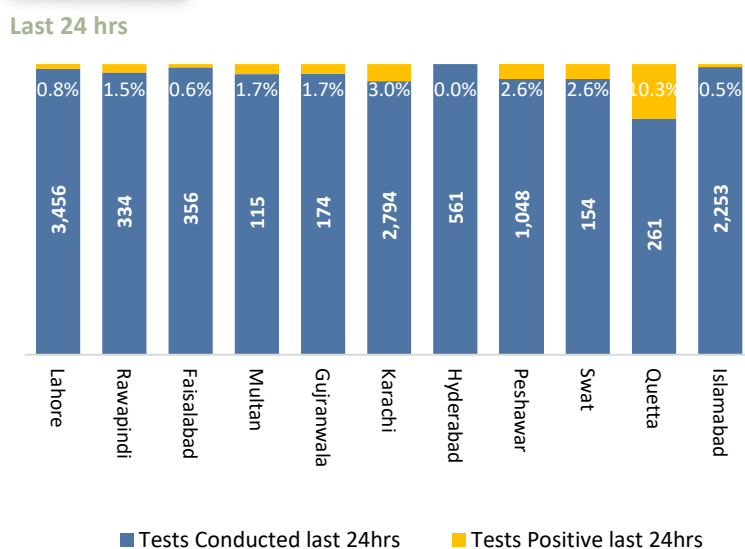
Daily COVID-19 Attack rate Per million population

COVID-19 Positivity rates by Major Cities / Districts



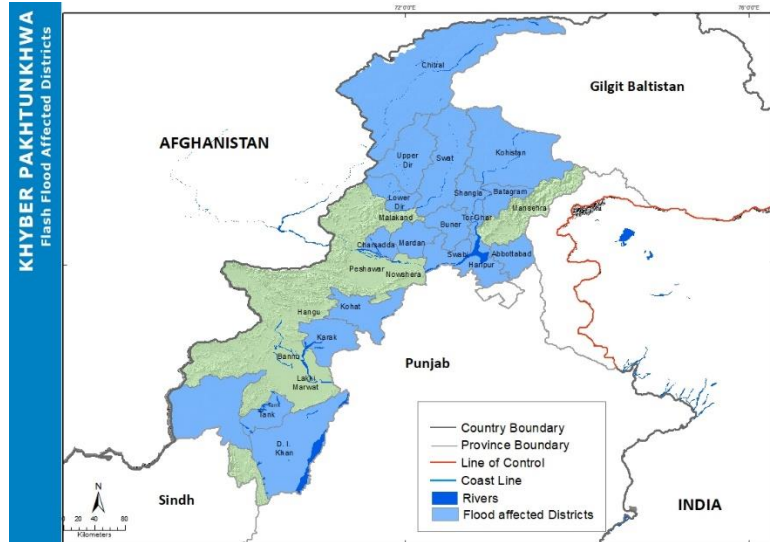

FLOOD SITUATION

Tuesday, 8th September 2020

In Pakistan, during last spell of monsoon rains, no new incident was reported in province of Punjab, Balochistan, Sindh and AJK. According to NDMA (from 6th to 7th September 2020) most of the impact of the rains and floods occurred in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa province, which recorded **2** new deaths due to landslide in village Mahting Yarkhoon in District Chitral, **1 house** fully damaged in district Kurram and **38 houses** partially and **3 houses** fully damaged in district Buner. To date over **248 deaths**, over **170** Injuries have been recorded as a result of heavy rains and floods in the country. Over, **1,370 houses fully** and **1,303 partially** damaged since 15th June. See the table below for details.

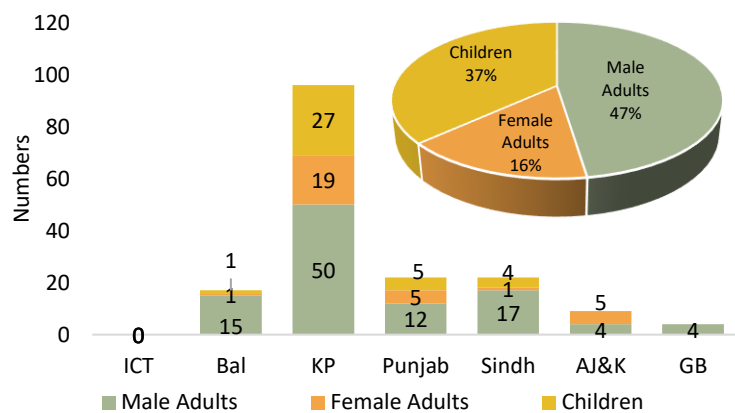

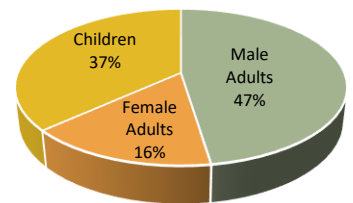
