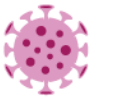
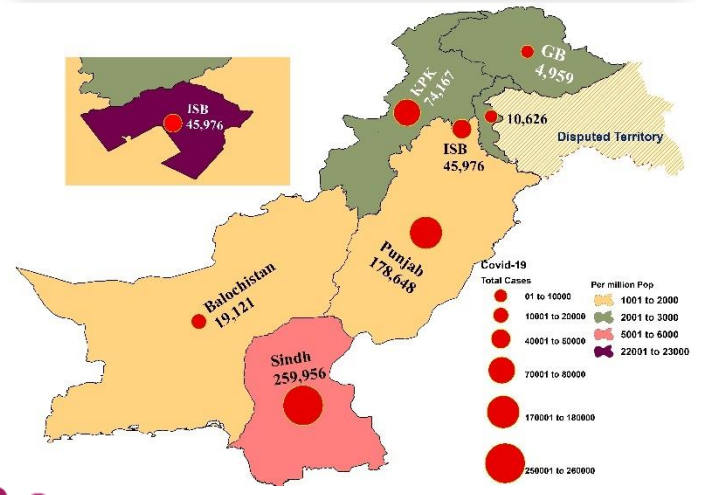

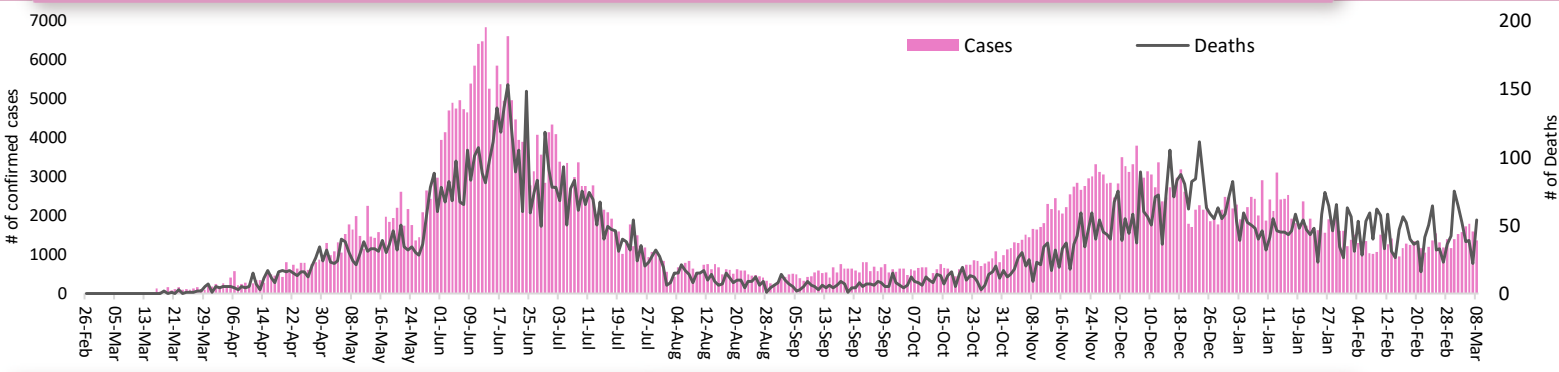

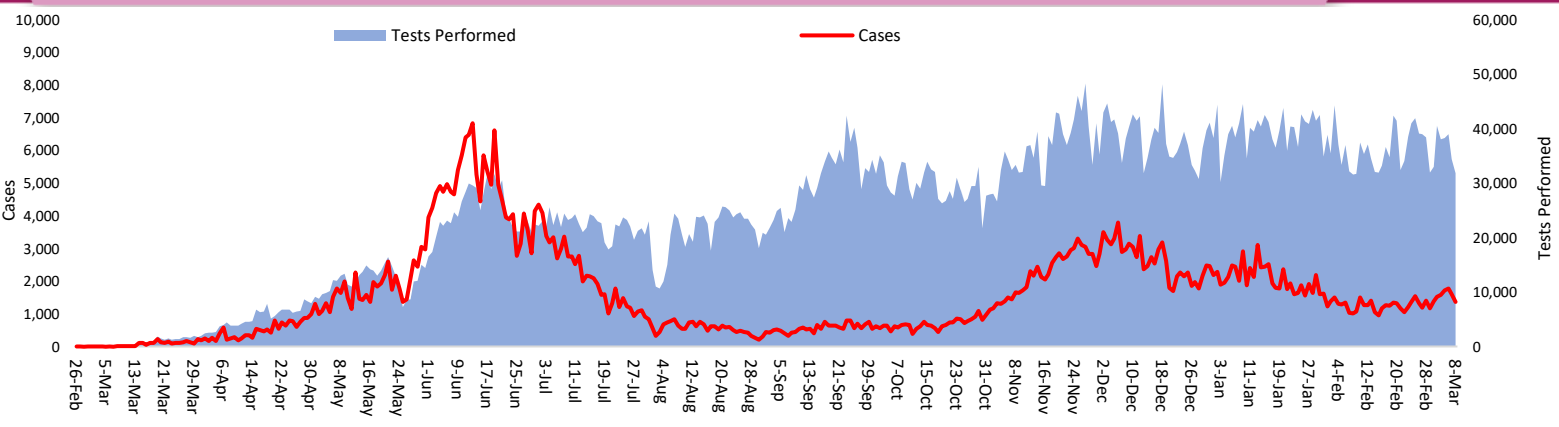

MEETING AND COORDINATION
