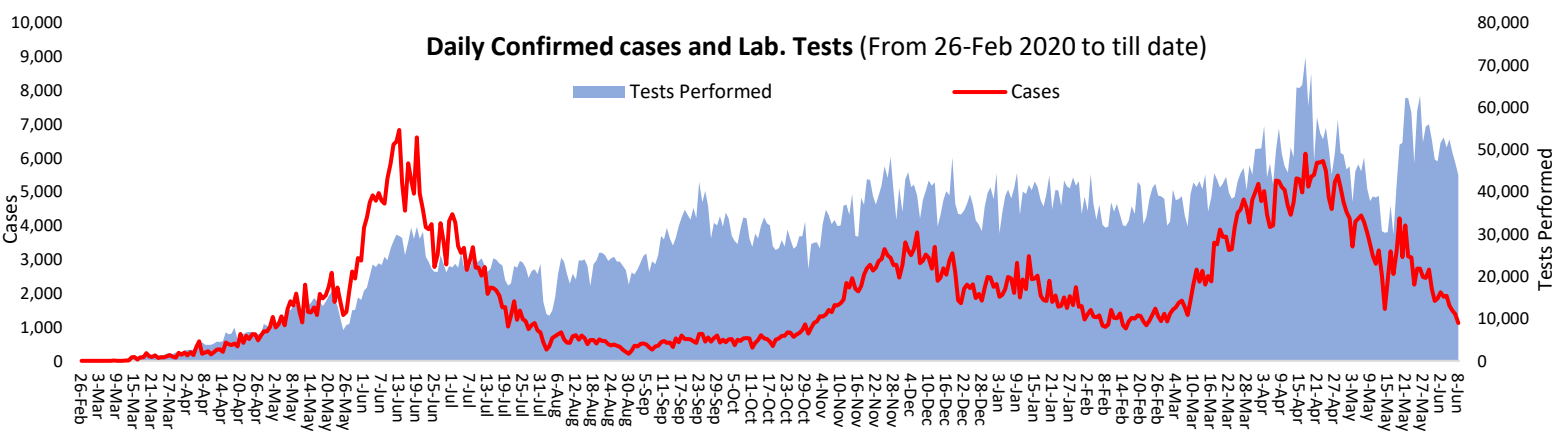
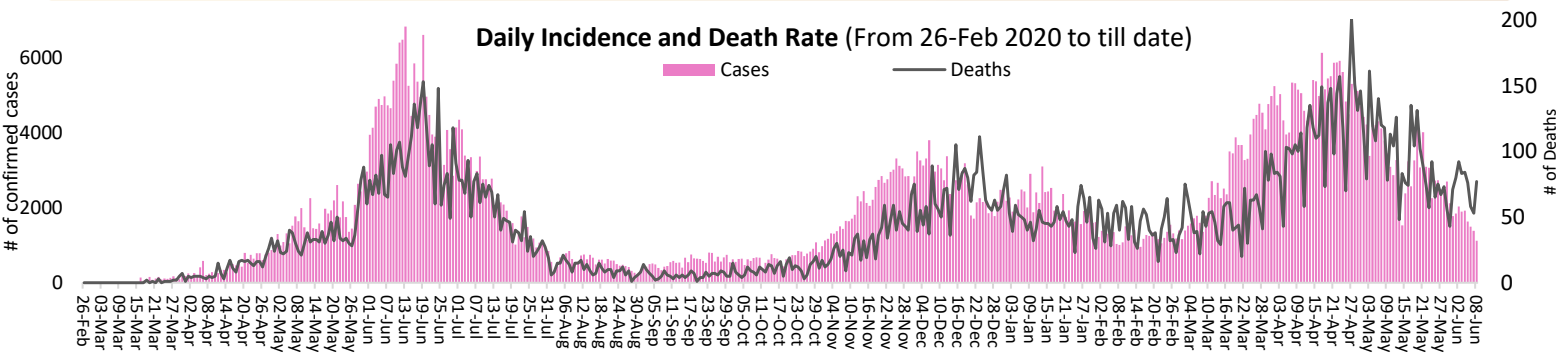

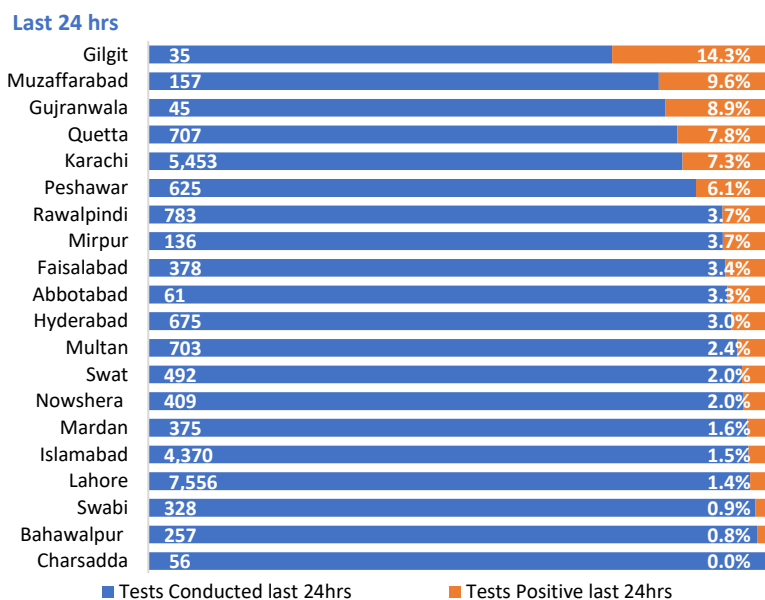
Meeting and Coordination



On 6th June 2021, WHO Regional Director for the Eastern Mediterranean Region, Dr Ahmed Al-Mandhari and WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala inaugurated a gym in the residential area of the National Institute of Health (NIH), Islamabad. The ceremony was attended by the Executive Director National Institute of Health, Prof. Maj Gen. Amir Ikram. WHO Pakistan has supported open air gyms with free access to the public, as a way of promoting physical activity that is crucial in the fight against Non communicable diseases (NCD). NCD accounts for 57% of all deaths nationally in Pakistan.

During the occasion, Dr. Al-Mandhari reiterated the role of physical activity in maintaining good health. He encouraged everyone to make good use of the facility and reduce premature death.
